

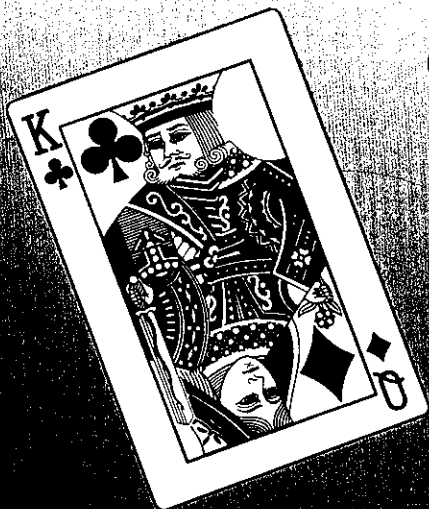

1. Minutes of the Last Meeting ACTION
Under A.B.O., 2nd paragraph under (a), 'Director' should be replaced by 'Tournament Operations Committee'.
2. Matters arising from the minutes of the last meeting
CW had not issued notice in respect of not to bring own food to venue. CW
The multifunction printer could not be repaired. Replacement was required.
- 3a. Venice Cup and World Junior Bridge Team Championship:
For Venice Cup, there was registration from Shirley Chang, Shirley Leong, IH, Nancy Neumann and Christine Booth. DZ advised that other than this team there was no other registration. However, he had been approached by some members to see if registration with conditions was acceptable and he duly advised them that the registration had to be clear and without conditions. The Council accepted the present registration and due to the tight time limit, IH would inform them to find the sixth member and see if they could appoint an NPC. IH
Captain's report for WJBTC was outstanding. DZ would follow up with DC for the report. DZ
- 3b. Intercity 1999
The report from the organizing committee was tabled and discussed. A surplus of \$107,013.70 was recorded. In addition to the points raised by AC in the report, SW and IH advised that the Hotel should be more cooperative. They had difficulty in unloading of equipment and tolls as the Hotel only allowed them to use one lift and the cargo bay was only available for 2 hours. The members accepted the report and agreed to pass the message to the organizing committee of 2000 Intercity.
- 3c. Finance
SW reported that a surplus of \$6,280 was recorded since last meeting excluding the surplus from Intercity.
- 3d. Roster for Paul Jones Duplicate pairs
SK would serve for October. IH would serve for November.
- 3e. Membership and Attendance of Tournaments

SW reported that the average number of tables in tournaments was 14 for August and 16.6 for August and 11.7 for September.
330 members had joined the Association.

4. A.O.B
 - a. Venues
Recently some late change had to be arranged because the Hall of Mariner's Club was not available for some Fridays. As it was not desirable for the HKCBA's operation, DZ suggested to contact the manager of Mariner's Club to see if he could ensure availability of venue. The members also agreed that tournaments could be held on weekdays other than Friday. IH would negotiate with the manager for details.
 - b. Directors' Training Course in Malaysia IH
KC and Cathy Lee were appointed to attend the course.
 - c. Duplicating Machine
DZ advised that his secretary could not afford to deal the hands at work as it was time-consuming and the noise was significant. An alternative was to ask his office assistant to do the work with nominal fee. It was agreed that \$50 would be paid for dealing each set of 32 boards.
 - d. Robert Zajac's Column in SCMP
Robert Zajac's had recently written a number of articles criticizing the Council as well as players. As these comments were not all based on facts, it was agreed that a letter to the editor be written to clarify the matters.
5. Date of Next Meeting CC
The date of next Meeting would be on 1 November 1999 at the same venue.

1. Minutes of the Last Meeting ACTION
Under para. 3a 'Captain's report for WJBTC should be read as 'Captain's report for PABF Open Team'
2. Matters arising from the minutes of the last meeting
CW had not issued notice in respect of not to bring own food to venue. CW
DZ would follow up further about PABF open Team Captain's report with DZ
Simon Hui.
- 3a. Venice Cup and World Junior Bridge Team Championship:
For Venice Cup, the sixth member would be Ella Graca. The team had approached Ashley Lung to act as team captain and he might go if he could take sufficient holiday. The Council reminded the team that only confirmed suggestions might be proposed by the team. IH would inform the team and Ashley Lung accordingly. Despite there was still no captain for the team, training had been carrying out by the team members with lectures by guest speakers as well as practice session arranged with experienced players. IH
Shirley Chang requested the Council to inform Mr. Timothy Fok, the president of the Sports Federation & Olympic Committee of Hong Kong, about the problems and issues faced by Hong Kong Women Team and look for any assistance from the Committee. DZ would issue letter to Mr. Fok. DZ
AC distributed to the members and the Women team a copy of the latest WBF Code of Practice of Appeals Committee to be applied to all National level tournaments from the coming Bermuda Bowl and Venice Cup.
DC presented the Captain's report of WJBTC. The report was adopted by the members.
- 3b. Tournament Format of 2000
AC's report and CC's comments were discussed. The members agreed that there would be no need for 12 sessions year-round events. - 3a. Venice Cup

1999 年全國“百齡杯”橋牌錦標賽

The 1999 All China 'Ba Ling' Bridge Championship

1999年10月5日到10月8日在浙江省奉化市溪口鎮舉辦第13屆全國“百齡杯”橋牌邀請賽共24隊參加比賽，分三組，不設種子隊，每組首二名出線，結果抽籤分在A組的有1998年第一名安徽隊，第二名啟東隊，第三名上海鐵路隊，1997年冠軍山西隊，多屆獲得前三名的上海隊（本屆最後得到冠軍）再加上香港隊、紹興隊、甘肅隊。（只有這三隊從未獲得過名次）A組被公認為最強的組。今年代表香港老年的是Chan Yiu, Ella Graca, Samme Lee, Lam Shee。很多人評價這個香港隊陣容是遇強隊不弱，遇弱隊不強，這次真的又一次基本靈驗。第一場對紹興隊（A組最弱的隊，最後是A組第八）就打成15:15（以下我們將我隊自認為處理較好的牌寫出來，請大家指教）。

The 13th All China 'Ba Ling' Bridge Championship was held in the scenic town "Qi Hou" in the Chekiang province from 5-8, October, 1999. 24 teams participated and divided into 3 sections with top 2 to enter into the finals. Hong Kong, consisting of Chan Yiu - Lam Shee, Ella Graca - Samme Lee was in A Section, strongest no doubt with last year's defending champions, and the mighty Shanghai Team, multiple and this year's winners. Consistent to the criticism that HK performs well against strong teams but poorly against weaker ones, we could only draw with the weakest team 15-15 in 1st match. Below are some of the hands from the tournament.

北家拿 14 分,叫上 3NT。但西家二次錯失機會,所以給香港隊北家做成。東首攻♠2,依次♠J,♠K,♠x,西續攻♠(無可厚非)北用♠A拿,出♣x,東墊♦x,這已說明東應是 4450 牌型,但為何不攻♥呢,必是拿着♥間張,而♥K是無望得墩的。故從明手出♦,西上♦A(或許 Duck)更好,或許他認為同伴有♦K或♦Q)但這是西最後一次進手,仍然相信同伴的♠而未出♥于是莊家連打♣,迫東墊牌,東不能墊♦只能墊♥(或♠都一樣),最后被莊家用♥投入,計得♠2墩,♣4墩,♦3墩,完成定約。

The bidding was reasonable though not distribution of the hand, West erred and allowed the contract made. East led S2, J, K, x. West continued Spade, A, 3, 8. Next came Cx, Dx from E, A, x. As East clearly showed a 4450 distribution, a Diamond was played from dummy. West rose with his Ace, and leading for the last time, played his 3rd Spade, probably trusting partner to take 2 tricks there. Now

declarer could march off the Club winners squeezing but East's winners and had to succumb the ninth tricks to HK or D10. In the end, it was 2 Spades, 3 Diamonds, 4 Clubs.

Some players with the West hand would prefer take-out double while some may simply pass; the 9 points may arguably be good or bad, opener could easily have 3, 4 cards fit on the bidding or bad misfit. Anyway, SA was led following by 2 more rounds, South switched to his lone trump, taken by H9 in dummy, now HJ and won by North's K who exited Diamond, also 3 down, -800 and 11 IMPs to H.K.

Both Easts attacked with Clubs, won by dummy's 9, HQ finessed, HA, noticing H10 dropped, HJ came next taken by West who switched to Spades on signal, but 9 tricks were there, defence could not have more than 2 Spades, HK,DA. However, if DJ were switched instead of Spade, 9 ticks would be difficult.

A trump was led, contract made losing a trick in each side suit. The other room was EW 5H down one, and a net 390.

第六場對上海隊，擁有前國手陳榮昌及陸玉麟的隊，無疑實力很強，但全隊實力不平均。我們幸運勝23:7。我們‘滾’了一副牌，幸好陳榮昌坐西。

Match 6 against Shanghai with 2 ex-national players Chen Rangchang and Lu Ruiren who fortunately were with weaker partners, we won 23:7.

We were lucky to have Chen sitting West here and 'stole' a homerun:

事後陳榮昌分析，如果北主動叫上6C則首攻應是♥K，如南叫上滿貫，可首攻♠A，即使敵方有♠K，多數在南手上，你同意嗎，實際首攻♥K，二邊都是首攻♥K，二邊都取得13副，但上海隊叫到5C最佳合約反而輸牌。

比賽牌數不多時，弱隊可勝強隊，也許這是橋牌吸引人的原因之一吧。

Chen commented that if North actively bid the slam, he would lead HK; if South, SA, since if SK is on their side, most likely it would be South, agree? Shanghai reached the best 5C contract and HK was lead both tables. The hands: A easy 13 tricks were made in both rooms, unfairly, or without Chen on lead.....

完成定約無困難，4H was made with easy.

預賽最後一場對啟東隊，由於香港連勝三場積分已變為香港(111)，上海(103)，安徽(100)，啟東(99)，形勢對啟東不利，必需要大勝香港隊才能出線，所以他們拼搏很兇，而香港則穩扎穩打，以25:5大勝對手。預賽結果：香港以不敗戰績贏得A組第一(VP 136)，B組第一浙江一隊，(VP128)，C組第一浙江二隊(VP126)。

The last match was against Kai Tung and we were leading 111 to Shanghai's 103 after 3 good wins. The pressure was on Kai Tung who had to win big to qualify. H.K. had a steady game and won 25:5. So surprisingly, we were undefeated and bested the section, in fact the whole field with 136 out of 175 VPs.

The Finals 6 teams appeared equal contestants, out disadvantage was that we were a 4-man team, average age over 65 and energy sapping, which became apparent particularly after tough battles like against Shanghai with a lucky win. This hand came from the match we lost 11:19 to Chekiang:

雙方不知為什麼，都由北主打 3NT，首攻♠3（長4），請問如果何繼續，明手放♠x西出♠7即使先打♥A，出♦J，仍舊得墩。第4墩如何打？實戰中出♠x送給東，東只好再出♠，當時看到東出的是♠6，想想不應是5張（未見♠2），那麼東是出4333牌型還是4423呢，總之，判斷低花不應多過3張，於是上♠K，也許是上♠10較好，無論如何♠一定要輸二付，實戰中由於東出明手叫過的♠，應有4至5張♠，如果♣有4張，應首攻♣，四家牌如下：

From the available information, East led S3. Small from the next 2 hands, HA, DJ, all winning, how would you play your 4th trick? 8 apparent tricks now. In actual play, declarer exited with a Cx to East who returned another Spade, the 5 (S2 not seen yet), so his probably distribution was 4432 with majors or 4333, remember the bidding? Declarer so went up SK, planning perhaps to lose 2 Spades, a Diamond, a Club. A minor suit could have been led with 4 cards there, the hands:

在♠取得三墩後，照實際的牌情，防守方已不能擊敗定約，無論莊家是拔光邊套，用♦套投入東家，東只有♥可出，或者用第4張♣送入西家，西也只有♥或♦可出，都完成定約，唯一不能完成定約的防守，是在西用♠A蓋吃♠K，後出♥，只要莊家不飛♥，一樣可成定約，如飛♥，將使牌鎖在明手，不能成約。

After capturing SK with Ace, the only defence that might cause problem was Heart return but if refrain from finessing, he would prevail on the lie of the cards, making 2 Clubs, 2 Diamonds 2 Hearts and 3 Spades.

The finals result were :Shanghai:88, Chekong:87, HK:86, the rest:70,60,58. Altogether, it was close, any hand could have elevated s to the top, perhaps undeservedly. Anyway, it was our best result so far.

The 1999 U.S. Spingold Bridge Championship was held in July, 99, San Antonio with 111 teams participating. No. 1 seed was Nickell (Freeman, Hamman-Soloway, Meckstroff- Rodwell) and the 4 semi-finalists were: Nickell vs Lev, Beatty vs Baze. The final was Nickell, Beatty. Here we concentrate mostly on Nickell's performance in the semi and finals..

Result: Open lead D9 by East, Somehow declarer took 13 tricks.

Facts: 4NT was alerted, EW didn't ask for explanation. 5D was alerted, and was explained as one A. The EW pair after the hand was over, called the Director and contested that in HKCBA's handbook, Blackwood is 'not to alert' ie 4NT bid 'should not' be alerted. If South hasn't alerted 4NT, the 5D can be interpreted ambiguously, therefore, EW felt there was damage to EW pair.

Director's Ruling: The Director ruled that the 4NT bid in this case could be alerted (also could be not alerted), he did not see any infraction of the law and hence the table score stands.

EW appealed, given the reason as stated above.

Appeal Committee Decision: The committee was unanimous in upholding the Director's ruling and 3:2 in favour of confiscating the deposit.

- 1) There is quite a lot of confusion about whether it is necessary to alert some common conventions eg Blackwood, Stayman, transfer. it is not surprising that most local players are at a loss of what to do and what not to do.
- 2) Even if we look at WBF alert policy, which overrides all zonal or BCBO procedures, it states:

"Conventional bids should be alerted, non-conventional bids should not". However, it also says "All bids, with the exception of conventional opening suit bids, at the 4 level or higher" should not be alerted.

This is again quite confusing, as the two statements are somewhat contradictory. It is the WBF practice to advise players that when in doubt, they should alert rather than not.

- 3) In the case under consideration, with a contested action, it should be normal for a player to alert a conventional bid rather than not. We don't see an infraction there. Since there is no infraction, the score at the table must stand according to the law.
- 4) The damage to EW was not due to the bidding, actually 7NT could not make. Their loss came entirely from their mis-defence. So we totally disagree with the appeal of their statement. "This slam was mis-defended. However, we believe this was besides the point."
- 5) The director was summoned after the hand was over. If EW was so keen on the law, they should have called the Director when dummy's hand was tabled. We are sure if 7NT went one down (as it should), EW would never call the Director.
- 6) We found the case appalling. Having defended horrendously in order to let 7NT through, EW had the guts to ask for redress.

It is due to the last two reasons that the committee decided (3:2) to forfeit the deposit.

Chairman's Comment: I find the tendency of shifting of attitude towards this game alarming. I hope we can all remember Bridge is supposed to be a competition of judgement, skill, concentration and partnership understanding. Law of contract bridge is there to protect the innocent, not to be used as a means to cover one's mistake.

Result: South lead a Diamond; North took with the K and shift to a Spade. 5D made 11 tricks.

Facts: 4S was explained as 5-5 minor plus points. However, there was no convention card at the table. North claimed because 1D showed <7 HCP, had he known East was not 5-5 minor, he would play Ace of Club to see the signal, with East 5-5 minor (as explained), there is no hurry to cash club.

Director's Ruling: In the absence of convention card, this is taken as a mis-explanation by EW, and hence the result adjusted to 5D down 1.

EW appealed, stating that according to the system, 4S means what W had explained. E knew (subsequently) that he had bid incorrectly but he felt he had no responsibility to alert NS of his misbid.

Appeal Committee Decision: The committee decided (4:1) in upholding the Director's decision. The deposit to be returned.

- 1) If EW could produce their system at the table and if \$\$ did mean 5-5 minor, our conclusion might be different.
- 2) However, in the absence of a convention card, the WBF & PABF practice is to consider that the bid is correct and if the explanation is different it will be considered as misexplanation.
- 3) Following that spirit, the benefit of doubt should go to the non-offending side, hence we ruled 5D down 1.
- 4) As one of the committee members pointed out, in theory North had some contributing error in returning Spade at trick 2. It would be simple for him to lay down the Club Ace, watch partner's signal, before deciding to continue club or switch to a spade. If East was short in spades, South would have at least 6 times Spade to the Ace, wouldn't he overcall 1S?
- 5) Nevertheless, nobody will expect players to come up with perfect solution all the time. The spade return at trick two is a bit weak but acceptable, hence our majority decision.
