(b) Intercity - A. I.A. has agreed to sponsor HK\$35,000. Cost for souvenir Next Meeting bag is HK\$18 each. Order for trophies has been placed with Perfect but can be cancelled before June 10. However, in anticipation of low turn-up from Mainland China and Japan because of SARS, FW will approach Regal Kowloon Hotel for postponement of the event (at same rates) until, say, December 9 to 14, failing which Intercity 2003 will be cancelled and the first deposit of HK\$70,000 will be forfeited by Regal.

(c) 42nd PABF representation and delegates: Since the Philippines has adopted strict quarantine policy towards
travelers from Mainland China and possibly other SARS hit countries, China
cannot send any team to participate for this PABF. PABF Executive
Committee will request PTBA to re-consider scheduling this PABF to some

It was resolved that CY and FW will be our delegates to attend the Delegates' Meetings to be held before PABF.

It was also resolved that the following subsidies be granted : -

It was resolved that no penalty will be imposed on K.F. Mak who was banned by his team captain Lawrence Lau to play in National Team play-off when he knew he could not play for PABF in June because of schooling deferred due to SARS. He is entitled to have 1 Placing Point only, as compared to 3 earned by other members of the winning team.

- 4. Tri-angular Interport AC will negotiate with Guangzhou for swapping hosting right with them so as to schedule this event before the deferred Intercity 2003 in order to negotiate a better deal with Regal Kowloon Hotel.
- 5. A. O. B. :-
 - (a) To celebrate the Golden Jubilee Anniversary of the Indonesian National Contract Bridge Association, an Indonesian Open Bridge Tournament will be held at Batam from July 4 to 13. LLO will post the details on web.
 - (b) In anticipation of low turn-up, tournaments will be moved from Hall to conference rooms on 5/F as far as possible. However, the first session of Open Team of Six must be held at Hall so that players may get use to the special movement first. All Promotional Pairs, Special Pairs and Team and Intercity Trial will be changed to MP/IMP pairs with cash prices.
 - (c) The National Team Trial format adopted this year will not be applicable to next year as 4 teams at most can be sent to attend the 2004 PABF Congress in Taipei. Separate trial will be held if necessary.
 - (d) Paladin Chan's team did not show up for Open League 9. Their deposit had been forfeited and the warning letters will be sent by DN to the team captain.
 - (e) Upon stock taking by DN as part of the handover procedures to BZ, it was revealed that 200 bidding boxes were lost. Further checking being done by DN. On the other hand, only 30 sets of screens will be kept.
 - (f) It was resolved that a vote of thanks be extended to DN for his unreserved efforts contributed to the Tournament Operations Sub-committee in the past 2 years.

Registration for the Pairs and Swiss Team events will be accepted at the venue during the tournament. Teams who are interested in the Open or Youth series must register with the association on or before 30 September 2003. There will be no trials for the Youth Teams, and they will play in their own section if the total entries in the category exceed 7.

We can, at this point, guarantee 9 positions for the Open series. If the number of registered teams exceeds 9, there will be trials, to be held in October.

If there is trials for the Open series, the tournament fee will be HK\$320 per team per session. The winner of the trials will receive a 50% discount on the entry fee while the 1^{st} runners-up will receive a 20% discount.

All registered players must be members of HKCBAL that the membership fees must be fully paid to HKCBAL; and all accepted teams must pay the entry fees on or before November 1, 2003, otherwise the team would be considered as "overseas team".

Due to the unpredictable SARS situation, the Executive Committee of the PABF has made the decision to delay the Championships to *August 29* ~ *September 7, 2003*. 香港代表隊選拔賽 Hong Kong Selection Trial


爲參加今年在菲律賓舉行的太亞區橋牌賽,香港舉行了一連串代表隊選拔,這次選拔賽跟往年不同,需獲得全年聯賽冠軍,即 Open Team, Open League 及 Master Team 的優勝者,以及舉行 IMP 論對比賽,再選出一隊,共四隊進入選拔階段,優勝者即是香港代表隊。於四月底剩下兩隊,進行決賽,打 128 副牌,我抱著這樣的心情去觀看比賽,看看香港隊目前的水平,一方面向他們學習,一方面看看那些可以改進的地方,提出來供代表隊參考。可惜的是,只進行了 32 副牌比賽,就因故停止了。

To prepare for the coming PABF to be held in Manila, Philippines, Hong Kong had a selection trial, which was the different format than previous years: 4 teams that had won the year's Open Team, Open League, Master Team plus, a team from the special IMP Pairs Trial, were invited to play a final trial with winners to represent Hong Kong. I watched the match between the 2 final teams, 128 boards hopeful of getting a glimpse of standard at this level and getting something out of them.



照牌的分配,只要東西的 ♥ 是 3-2 分配,二個紅色 K 有一個對位,合約就回家了。牌正是這樣分配的,但第三墩出 ♥Q 後,除非東家立刻用 ♥K 拿,你才有二次機會進明手飛 ◆K,而這 ◆K 又是剛好對位,否則只有第四墩時你用 ♥A 把東的 ♥K 打下來,這幾乎是不可能的。正確的打法很簡單,第三墩出 ♥7 明手上 ♥10,無論東忍讓與否,明手必有二次進張飛二次 ◆,共得四墩 ♥、二墩 ◆ 和三墩 ◆。南家打得不好,但還嬴牌,因爲閉室叫到 5♥ 那是根本沒有機會的,結果下三,300 分。

Very good defense while declarer might be criticized for paying too much attention to the ♥ situation and overlooking 2 entries could be needed to bring in the ♦; therefore, to test the ♥ suit, low to 10 appeared to be the percentage play as East rated to have at least 1 red King if not both. Sure East could duck as before, but you could also finesse ♦ en route back for a 2nd ♥ play, the Queen if you wished, let go and perforce you had to take 9 tricks. In the other room, somehow, 5♥ was bid by N-S, 3 off for an unjust gain.







3NT would fail on a ♦ lead and wrong ♣ finesse while 12 or 13 tricks were there for the taking on 6♣ contract. Shouldn't such hands be included in Multi 2 instead? A swing of this size would certainly be ill-advised, 2NT without a high honor was risky and avoidable.





橋 牌 贏 墩 潛 力 Winning Potentials in Bridge

到目前爲止,還沒有一種制度(System)可以將任何一副牌都叫得很精確,計點法對初學者很好,但有很多牌特別是有牌型的牌,常常會低叫。大家都知道,橋牌是以贏墩來定輸贏,各種叫牌制度只是幫助你和同伴估計以某花色爲將牌(或無將牌)的贏墩數目,估計的準確就贏牌,不是說你點子多就贏牌。我們說某副牌的牌值好,是指贏墩多,想贏墩多有幾種情形:

- (一) 大牌點多,又有長套,這種情形平牌機會較大。
- (二) 大牌點雙方相若,但將牌極配,又不是 『對對糊』式的牌,這種牌很多橋友未能留意其巨大的贏墩 潛力。

下面我暫時只能舉些例子來說明,我還不能總結出一個規律。


Up till now, there doesn't seem to have a system that really covers all, to the Jack so to speak, the nearest perhaps are relay systems such as Ultimate or Viking Club, but then you would not, and should not in my opinion, be allowed a free run. Points are good to beginners but shapes have generally been overlooked relatively resulting many contracts being underbid. Bridge is for winning the maximum number of tricks, and partnership systems assist us to that end. Winning tricks usually can be achieved through (1) many high card points, long suits, but these normally mean tie results as about everyone can do that; (2) when high card points are about even for both sides, but one side has good trump fits and there is no mirroring distribution, then this is the situation for swings or potentials for winning. Here are some hands.



Old, wise text books teach us that, 26 points make 3NT or a major game, 29 points needed for minor, etc. However, I would say that with a void, a 9-card trumps fit, 16 points is good enough for major games. That hand was simply typical: void, 5-4 trump fit, points in Aces and Kings, you can use that almost as formula!





Result: games all failed, and 4 of the 7 made 4. Double dummy, we can all make 4 or 4 but Here's how 4 made in one table, quite logically.



The secret, if one exists, of winkling East's trumps was to understand that to succeed, East must have precisely 4-4-3-2 and the 2 Aces for the strip, 4-4-3-2 wouldn't yield a 2nd trick in \spadesuit for a 4th \heartsuit ruff, etc. The double-dummy defense of \spadesuit Q instead of \spadesuit A at the 3rd trick is too fancy for recommendation.

♣9 was led, the only suit that could defeat the contract! Declarer played Ace, then 3-round ◆ to discard ♠8; and on the 4th, over-ruffed North's ♣7 and exit with a trump. North won, thought for a while and played a ♥ back; thinking that partner had led from ♠KJ9 (East had discarded 8 on the 4th ◆). With K9, partner should have led King, playing declarer to have 2-1-2-8 distribution. That turned a good win to a bad loss. Was he right? But shouldn't declarer be clearly void in ♥ when partner bid 4♥ and 5♥ when he had himself 4 to the King. It is arguable which is the right lead. Personally, I think ♠9 led would be right if the bidding had been ... 6♠ and all passed while King in the present one, trusting partner's decision when you clearly told him you might have no defensive trick at all, where are the tricks, if one must come from ♠ then let partner know, why crucify him? I can understand the pressure leads, deceptive, etc., but is this hand, the bidding ... The swing of 23 IMPs decided the match as the hand occurred on the last segment, 209:193 IMPs.



首攻小 ♥ 到東 Ace,回攻 ♥5,西 ♥K 贏得轉攻 №4,明手上 ●K 贏得,出 ●J,依次 Q-K-4,下面你怎麼打?Zia 的打法是:出 ◆A、K,再出 Q 時東將吃,南超將吃再出 ●Q,逼西上手後沒有將牌可回,莊家之後將吃一墩 ●,共得六墩將牌、一墩 ●、二墩 ◆ 和將吃一墩 ● 共十墩。Zia 的主要判斷是東第一聲叫 2♥ 應該只有兩張,如有三張,似乎應叫 3♥, 於是判斷東家的高花爲 4-2,他就是按照這樣判斷而成功做庄。


A small was led to East's Ace who returned 5 to partner's King. West exited 4 to King in dummy. Zia played J from table, covered Q, K, 4. Now what? Zia confidently ventured forth A, K, then Queen was ruffed by East and over-ruffed. Next came Q to West's Ace, with no trump left, a was returned and ruffed in dummy, the 10 tricks, despite 4-1 trump break, were 6 trumps, one in A, 2 in and a ruff. Zia judged East to have 2 cards only otherwise he would have bid 3 instead. The trumps therefore split 4-1, the rest of the play was necessary basing on that assumption.


 \clubsuit 6 was led, taken by Zia's King who returned \clubsuit 2 creating a 4-4 break impression on the suit. Declarer won by Ace and played 4 rounds of \clubsuit and exited in \clubsuit . Rosenberg, normally the master defender, erred and discarded \blacktriangledown 2 and \spadesuit 2 on the \clubsuit , the ending:

Zia was squeezed but would have survived by discarding \blacklozenge had East kept his \blacklozenge and let go another \blacktriangledown . For normal souls like us, the hand might have gone routinely like, duck, duck in \spadesuit , won Ace and duck a \blacklozenge to West for a simple 9 tricks. Experts think in more complex ways, particularly Rosenberg, I think.

如果西家叫牌的 4♣ 改成 4NT,表示另一門高過 ♣ 的花色 (這裡當然指 5-4 或 6-4 牌型的 ♣ 和 ◆),加強阻塞,或者效果會更好。另一桌只叫到 4♣,因為 6♣ 是做不成的。

If West's 4 bid becomes 4NT, showing obviously the minors either in 5-4 or 6-4 shape, the result might be better as North could err given the few "schmoints" in hand. 4 was only reached in the other room, as 6 goes down incidentally here.
