President Report 2003

The past bridge year was a disruptive one. The unfortunately SARS incident has caused a suspension of our tournaments and activities for over a month. The annual Inter-city, originally scheduled for early August, was also re-scheduled for the latter part of November.

With a revised tournament format, the attendance has improved over last year. Our total membership was 319. We introduced new trials formats for the PABF Open Teams and found that there are difficulties in implementation. Revision to the format will be necessary for 2004/5.

As the PABF Championships was also re-scheduled to late August, our youth team was selected to represent Zone 6 in the World Junior Championship in Paris. The team had a high-flying start but alas failed to maintain the momentum, finishing 9th out of 16. Three teams, including Open, Youth and Senior, were sent to Manila for the 42nd PABF Championships. The Open Team finished 9th out of 11. The Youth Team finished 3rd out of 6. The Senior Team finished 4th out of 9 and made the play-off for a berth to the Senior Bowl, unfortunately losing to a much-stronger Indonesian team.

Locally, we continued to conduct classes and promotional activities at the grass-root level jointly with the Leisure and Cultural Services Department (LCSD).

Thanks to the continuous kind support of AIA, we were able to host several student events during the year with very good attendance. We hope that this will continue and build up the momentum of the sport amongst the student community.

I wish to take this opportunity to thank all council and sub-committee members for the hard work they put in during the year. I hope we will continue this co-operation spirit in the coming year.

9th World Youth Bridge Team Championship ~ 18-28 August 2003

In 2001, I was appointed by the council to take up the Head Coach of Hong Kong Youth team. Basically, I have a belief "more players = higher standard". I have been devoting my personal time for the youths. I felt satisfactory on the results and I believed I have achieved my personal goal.

Before going into the details of the report, I would like to thank 01/02 and 02/03 council to appoint me as the coach and npc of youth (and youth ladies), mentors including Anthony Ching, David Chan, Samuel Wan and SS Bux have also contributed a lot on the trainings.

And the most important of all, who really create the change, are the supporters of youths: the Youth Development Fund. The organizers: Nancy Neumann, Shirley Chang, Shirley Chiang, Shirley Hui and the sponsors are deserved for our highest respect. Without them, I don't think we can achieve the results that we had achieved. Although Hong Kong Youth still have a long way to go, and this is exactly why Youth Development Fund is so important in developing Youths.

Selection

More or less the same as last year, the selection trial was aimed at recruiting about 12 players, and from the 12 players, of which 2 pairs were selected by appointment. I should pick the best team to both PABF and World Junior. The core players of my ideal team include WK Lai, Yau Ngai and Henry Wong. However, Yau Ngai cannot attend the World Junior (noticed by the beginning of this year). The partnership of WK Lai and KF Mak seems to be the most solid pair. The preparation of Henry Wong and Samuel leong seems not sufficient. The question went to the third pair between LH Chin-CH Leung and Alick Ng- YC Lai. They are very close (even in the trial), but talking about experience and character, I believed that Ng-Lai will have the better confident both for myself and the teammates.

Strength and Weakness

With very limited experience in World Junior, I believed that to fight against European teams and US are very difficult. Famous players like Di Bello Brothers, Lo Presti and Mazzadi from Italy, de Tessieres, Bessis brothers from France, Mignocchi from US are brilliant (but not undefeatable) in declaring and defense. Not far from now, they will surely be one of the best international players in the world scene.

Before going to Paris, I understood and believed that one of the most important skills that I am confident in is slam bidding. Declarer play and defense standards should not be much inferior than the others. However, results showed that slams are the place that we lost the most victory points.

As an evaluation, I think we can improve the content of training in the following aspects:

- I think the major reason for the mistakes we committed is experience, the experience in play-off against strong teams. The experience of play-off with strong team can build up confidence, stamina and durance. These are the characters that we are not sufficient. We might take the chance of playing a berth of ladder A in some of the inter-club events in China. Say Guangzhou invitation.
- 2. Mentorship was proved to be successful. But most of our partnerships are short (at most 1 year compare with 5-8 years for European teams) and inexperience in handling new circumstances. Mentorship may start with young pairs to have more rooms to improve in partnership and understanding. I believed partnership is the area that we are far behind the European and the US teams.
- Experience and familiarization of the team with the NPC. Other than the mentorship, the NPC must know their team well despite all kind of barriers. In this aspect, I think players should have given their preference towards training than mentorship.
- 4. Formal trainings should be given to those aged around 18-19 with a regular partner and this is also the rationale behind the training for secondary schools.

Although Lai-Mak pair has the best performance among the 3 pairs, with an average of +7.4 IMPS/round which is lower than what we expected +15 IMPS/round. While Wong-leong scored -2.2 IMPS against expected +8 IMPS. Ng-Lai has an -3.6 Vs expected -5 and is the only pair performed better than what I expected.

The qualifiers of the round robin had scored at least 18.3VPs/round. Even if we have performed as expected, I think we will be something around 260-265 VPs, in which case we can achieve the position of 6-7. But 9th in the world is a respectable result and is just in line with my expectation.

Captain Report

42nd PABF Championship ~ August 29 to September 7, 2003 <u>Youth Team</u> *by Ringo Lee*

Selection

The 42nd PABF Youth Team was basically selected in late April because of SARS (and was approved by the council that 2 different teams will be sent to World Championship and PABF) and it is composed of 6 young boys without any international experience except Chin Lok Hang. The NPC for the team is Ringo Lee and the coach for them is Mr S.S. Bux.

Training

As a matter of fact, the 6 players were green in bridge, and they don't even have the necessary skills, which I thought is very basic. Moreover, it is a real difficulty to get the team into a good form within very short period of time because of a withdrawal of an original player because of his contract renewal, and 2 new partnerships were formed in July. Although it is very unlikely to defend the Champion with such young and green players, trainers like Anthony Ching, David Chan and S.S. Bux have contributed a lot of their precious time in training up the team. With very limited time for PABF team, I don't think I was very fluent with all of them.

Format

There were 6 teams participating in the 42th PABF Youth Series: The Philippines, Chinese Taipei, Indonesia, Japan, Singapore and Ourselves. The team which finished the first at the end of the third round robin is the winner. To arrange the line-ups, I tried to maximize the chance of defending the championship by setting up some assumptions:

- Regarding personal skills, experience and winning tactics, I believed that Chin-Leung pair
 is the outstanding pair, Fung-Lau is the second and Ng-Wong is the third, and my
 expectation is about +15, +7 and +/-0 imps respectively (with respect to this year's
 standard). With a total of 15 matches to go, I supposed the number of sessions should
 be 12, 11 and 7. If this came to be true, our average will be around 19VPs, and would
 turned out to be first or second.
- 2. After 1RR, some adjustment might be changed depends on the result of the 1RR and also the partnership.

Results

Despite the unpromising score of Chin-Leung pair, the team had a good result in 1RR compared with my expectation, we rank 1st at the end of the 1st round robin. Although the result of Fung-Lau pair is the best, it seems the skill set they acquired is better for weaker teams and did show some instability against better opponents. Ng-Wong pair is stable but not out-performing. Chin-Leung was quite disappointed in the match against Chinese Taipei, and seems to have some misunderstanding in high level biddings.

2RR is a nightmare for us, the objective for this RR, was to draw the strongest teams, which is Chinese Taipei and Indonesia and to win against weaker teams. The schedule of the RR is Phi, CT, Japan, Indonesia and Sing respectively. Fung-Lau and Ng-Wong are the pairs sent for the 1st match, but misunderstanding arises in Fung-Lau pair and they are off for 2nd match. Ng-Wong is off for the 3rd and the real disaster came with the 4th match against Indonesia which we lost 2-25. Another big negative datum scored by the Chin-Leung pair again which I cannot understand up to now. All 3 pairs did not perform well in the 2RR, and they performed poorly in the matches against Phi (Fung-Lau), Japan (Chin-Leung), Indonesia (Chin-Leung and Ng-Wong) and Singapore (Ng-Wong).

After the 2RR, we dropped to the 3rd place 34VPs and 9VPs behind Indonesia and Singapore and 25VPs ahead of Taipei. In 2RR, the skills of the Ng-Wong were known by the opponents and supposed that they would only have 2 more matches, that is Phi and Japan.

The crucial matches of the 3RR are 1st and the 4th against Sing and Indonesia. We needed to get big swings.

As shown from the datum, 2 of the 3 pairs are above the average cross the field and they performed better than my expectation. However, Chin-Leung are the most disappointed pair but they played against Indonesia 3 times and they scored –135 imps in total or –12.3 imps on average. Discount the matches against Indonesia, their datum is +4.2 which is still 10.8 imps behind my expectation. Hope they can work on the bidding style and their trust. Some of their mistakes are really ridiculous.

Conclusion


As I have mentioned many times,

- 1) The first and most important element of winning a RR is stability.
- 2) Fixed partnership is beneficial to the team to save time for training. Under my coaching or captaining, I will not allow to change partnership.
- 3) Selection trials should be arranged at the earliest possible period for better preparation, and I think HKCBAL is doing very well these years. At least, we are capable of sending 2 different teams to WBF and PABF.
- 4) Coach must have the absolute power over the team's discipline, training and selection to ensure the best line ups against different teams. Captain must have better understanding on the players but on the contrary, players have to know their captain well.
- 5) One of the very important elements of success is funding. Thank again, from the bottom of my heart, the patronage, organizers and the volunteers who contributed to the Youth Development Fund. Without any of you, I believed we have to search for players to form a team like 4 or 5 years ago.
- 6) Youngsters who is eager in representing Hong Kong as a youth or ladies player, there is no short cuts, improve your skills in declaring, bidding, defense, hand evaluation. Don't waste your talent.

二零零三年百齡盃橋牌邀請賽 2003 Baling Cup Invitation Tournament

今年在浙江省嘉興市舉行的百齡盃橋牌賽,共有二十四隊參加。分四組預賽,每組取二名,我們小組的第一名是上海隊,而我們與加拿大興南隊同分,並列小組第二名;但 IMP 比較小,被淘汰。而加拿大隊在決賽中,以不敗戰績取得第一名。我隊被淘汰原因多種,我想一個隊要在比賽中取得較好成績大概打每副牌都要精神集中,否則輸牌時才會發現:如果我這牌少宕一墩早已晉級了。或者這麼說,如果每個隊員都能像在橋牌會比賽時那麼樣,能發揮出每個人平時的水平,我想我們就能取得很好的成績!我舉些失敗的例子,請看平時這種牌會打錯嗎?

This year's competition was held in the historic city, Jiaheng with 24 teams participating divided into 4 sections. 2 top teams would qualify for further play for the Cup, the rest went for a Swiss Consolation. In our section, Shanghai came 1st while we and the Canadian Hing Nam Team tied 2nd on VPs but we had fewer IMPs gained and missed the cut. This Canadian Team went on to win the tournament undefeated. I guess there must be reasons for our failure and full concentration on each deal could prove vital as we had experienced here; any under-trick could have carried us through, our usual standard of play at the CBA also appeared lacking. Here are some of our bad hands; would we have erred, normally?





Ruff or discard? Well, I almost couldn't believe my own eyes when East threw a low ♠ while retaining the ♣ pips. Sure enough, the contract was made and we lost 12 IMPs.



Perhaps one should lead • or • under the circumstances. It was a big 6:24 loss and the chief reason we couldn't qualify.

HK Open Team Selection

The 2003 Hong Kong PABF Open Team was selected through several keen competitions. After the play-off (Alan Sze team VS Lawrence Lau Team) was completed. The following team was formed to represent Hong Kong in Philippines.

Practicing & Training

Due to SARS effect, 2003 42nd PABF CHAMPIONSHIPS was postponed from July to 28th August. On the time being, these 3 fixed partnerships training through HKCBA regular tournaments, Internet OK Bridge and regular practice 60 boards on Flora Wong home every Saturday.

Objective

Our objective is learning, improve & enjoy Bridge. We trusted playing without pressure, improve bridge skill, learning from mistakes and avoiding argument during tournament would gain the most valuable experience as well as our wish.

Championship Format

There were 11 teams participating in 42nd PABF Championships Open Series on 28-Auguest to 8-September in Philippines, namely, Australia, China, Chinese Taipei, Indonesia, Japan, Macau, Malaysia, Philippines, Singapore, Thailand and Hong Kong. Two complete round robins of 20-board matches will determine the final ranking of each country.

Results

Although we have a good start on the first match, won 23:7 against Malaysia, but we lost to China 7:23. On the 2nd day, we also lost to Australia 8:22, after we were able to fight back by winning Singapore 19:11, but we lost 3 matches consecutively. On 9 round, we fight to Japan win 17:13, but 10 and 11 round lost to Indonesia 9:21and China Taipei 5:25 .After 1RR, we are total gain 122 VP. 2nd RR – 1st match, we are against Australia but lost 12:18, and draw to China Taipei 15:15. After 4 matches, we lost more, only gain 39 VP. Although 7 round we won Philippines 22: 8, but other 3 matches, we still lost. As a result, 2RR we only collect 106 VP. Overall we finished 9th with a total of 228VP, average of 11.4 VP per match.

From this datum, the average VP gained by each pair was very close but unfortunately, no one exceeded our team expectation – average more than 15 VP per match.

Conclusion

All of us enjoyed the tournament and learnt much from this valuable experience. We summarize a few new findings to share with all of you:


- Trust your system and partner: when in doubt, think more about partner difficulty before further action.
- 2. Do not discuss and think about last mistake during match. You never find the same error that will happen again in the same match. Discussion with partner during the match may bring uncomfortably for both sides.
- 3. Don't be angry when partner make some mistakes.
- 4. Do not creat any illusion as partner doesn't know.

In general, result of Hong Kong Team in 42nd PABF CHAMPIONSHIPS is unsatisfactory. However, Hong Kong Open Team has already tried their best. I hope that HK team can improve their performance much next year. I wish Hong Kong open team to have better result next year for other international events.


葉氏杯擂台賽

每年在台灣高雄舉行的葉氏杯擂台賽水準都很高,除台灣本土的強隊參加外,還常邀請如印尼、日本、澳洲等等的強隊參加,特別是冠軍會獨得台幣二十萬元以上的獎金,很是吸引。香港隊先和大陸隊伍一起,參加 選拔賽,取二隊參加葉氏杯賽。其他的隊則參加副杯賽。

今年大陸只有五隊,加上我們共六隊選二隊,應該說機會比較大,因爲綜觀大陸五隊,沒有知名選手在內,各隊水平比較接近;比賽型式爲大循環,每輪打十副牌(六隊共打五輪),誰知第一場對廣州隊就輸 9:21。





附帶說一下,中國女隊對美國隊的決賽,如果這副牌打對,中國女隊已是世界冠軍了(當然機會不止這一次);美國女隊打 2NT,首攻 ▲J,她打對 ▲,超二,得 180 分,而中國女隊坐東西時叫牌:

首攻也是 ◆7, 西當然沒有 Hamman 那樣敏銳的感覺,明手放 ◆10, 南單張 Jack 贏得後出 ◆, 西上 ◆K, 但是 ◆ 打錯, 結果下四, 此牌輸 11 IMPs。如果此牌打成, 將會贏 9 IMPs, 來回相差 20 IMPs。不管怎樣, 這次是中國女隊離世界冠軍最近的一次了。

上面報導的是世界頂尖高手的錯誤,可能我們在疲倦時,犯錯會更多吧!
