# 2012 全國 A 類俱樂部聯賽 總決賽

# China Club A League 2012 Final Competition

2012年11月29日到12月5日舉行了全國A類俱樂部聯賽總決賽,這是全國最高級別的比賽,只有4隊參加,我關心的是,那些牌值得我們老年隊學習,那些牌我們要注意,避免犯同樣的錯。

The Final Competition of China Club A League was held from 29 Nov to 5 Dec 2012. This is the highest level of competition in China. Only 4 teams participated. My concern was to find out the boards which our senior team should learn and what similar mistakes we should avoid.

我只看了在 BBO 上出現的一部分牌 I have only watched some of the boards which were broadcast on BBO.

(1) 先説滿貫叫牌 Let's talk about slam bidding first.



坐東是著名中國國家隊員施豪軍(Shi HJ),他分析同伴的牌 13-15 的 1NT,只要同伴在黑牌上有支持,即有♠A 和♣K,已有 10 墩牌。在 6◆後叫 X,應該表示◆上沒有大牌,如果同伴能有◆控制(一定是◆A),建議叫牌。否則就 Pass ,這 Dbl 叫品值得我們學習。

The one who sat East was China's famous national team player HJ Shi. He analysed

his partner's 1NT of 13—15 points. If his partner had support in the black suits, i.e., ♠A and ♣K, then they would have 10 tricks. His partner's double after 6♦ indicated no honor in the ♦ suit. If Partner had control in ♦ (it must be ♦A), it suggested partner to bid, else to pass. This Dbl bid is worth our learning.

請看 4 家牌, 7♣是鐵牌。叫牌中,南北不能判斷 7♣是否成約,否則叫 7♥啦。 Please see the 4 hands. 7♣ was cold. From the bidding, North and South could not judge whether 7♣ could be made, else they would have bid 7♥.

Perhaps East considered that they held jointly 26—28 points only and was insufficient to bid a slam. He passed after 5♦. It was difficult to bid a grand slam after 6♦. In practice, 6♥ down 2 and North and South won 18 IMP.



As there is  $1^{st}$  control in every suit and a long and strong  $\blacktriangle$  suit, it is quite reasonable to bid  $7 \spadesuit$  or 7NT. You will be home if you can find the  $\spadesuit$ Q. The plays at both tables are similar. Win the  $1^{st}$  lead, play the  $\spadesuit$ A at trick 2, the  $\spadesuit$ 9 at trick 3, East follows with the  $\spadesuit$ 7, and Declarer  $\spadesuit$ J $_{\circ}$ 

Why did he identify the ♠Q to be with East? I don't know. Can the Declarer of 7NT play 3 rounds of ❖s and 3 rounds of ❖s before testing the ♠s?



South's 3 • was a very good bid. East and West cannot have the chance to find their 4 —4 fit in ♠s. It would be better for West to bid 4 ♠ instead of 4 NT after 4 • .. If East's 6 ♣ indicated no other K, West should not have bid 7 ♣ because he had 2 small ♥s, one of which could be discarded under the •A, the other ♥ loser could not be avoided. This is one of common mistakes made by our Senior Team.

我們都知道,橋牌是講嬴墩的,配合的牌,才能有更多的嬴墩,有配合加上適當控制,就要考慮試探滿貫,不要輕易止叫。

All of us know that bridge is dependent on winning tricks. More winning tricks can only be possible with matching. If there are suitable controls, we should make a slam try and should not close bid easily.



May be due to the bidding system, 2 ♦ is not game forcing and so 2NT is also not game forcing. After 3 ♦, there is no more forcing bid. We now play 2 over 1 and 2 ♦ is game forcing. After 3 ♦, you can bid 3 ♠. As you have not bid 2 ♠ after 2 ♥, the 3 ♠ now should be a cuebid (North should know it is the ♠K), North will then bid 4 ♦, South 4 ♥ (with the ♥A) and it is reasonable to bid a slam this time.


When you see the 4 hands, ◆Q is on side. Irrespective of the 1<sup>st</sup> lead, both 6♦ and 6♠ can be easily made. If the ◆Q is with East, when ◆s are 2—3 and ♠ s are not worse than 4—2, 6♦ can also be easily made. Our teammates usually bid 3NT after 3♦. As you have honors in Partner's 2 suits, you have to inform him so that he can re-evaluate his hand properly to avoid missing a slam. You see, after you have successfully finessed , you will have 13 tricks. As you have fit in 2 suits, you can win 13 tricks with a total of 29 points. You should have bid at least 6♦.



(2) 搶部分定約不積極 Not aggressive enough to compete for part-scores 這本是我們隊的缺點,高手對陣中,部分定約雙得的機會不會太多。

This is a weakness of our team. In experts' matches, it is rare to win part-scores at both tables.





# 23 屆華夏友好城市老年橋牌賽 The 23<sup>rd</sup> Hua Xia Friendly City Senior Bridge Competition

2012年11月在深圳舉行第23屆華夏友好城市老年橋牌賽,有52隊參加,由於時間限制,2天的預賽,只能和8個隊交流,加上第3天決賽,最多和11個隊相遇。比賽採用手發牌,沒有牌型紙,所以下面牌例,有可能寫錯。

In November 2012, the 23<sup>rd</sup> Hua Xia Friendly City Senior Bridge Competition was held in Shenzhen. 52 teams participated. Due to the time constraints, we could only play against 8 teams in Days 1 and 2, and 3 teams in the final in Day 3 and so we could only play against 11 teams in total. We shuffled the cards ourselves and there were no hand records available. So, I might write the following examples incorrectly. 我們隊沒有進入前 8,參加剩餘 44 隊的瑞士賽,名列第 5。我認為我們最大缺點,和弱隊交鋒,不但不能大比數勝出,有 2 場都輸 2IMP(14: 16),我們對強隊,進入前 8 的安徽老年隊,勝 5IMP (16;14)。和湖南株州老年隊(7: 23)。 我們 8 場牌平均 16.1VP,和第 8 名相差 6VP。

Our team was not among the top 8 after Day 2 and so we just competed in the Consolation Swiss Team among the remaining 44 teams and we came  $5^{th}$  on Day 3. I consider the major weakness of our team is that we could not have large wins against the weak teams and even lost 2 rounds by 2 IMP (14: 16). However, we won a strong team — Anhui Senior Team which was among the top 8-5 IMP (16;14) and Hunan Zhuzhou Senior Team (7: 23). Our average result was 16.1 VPs for the  $1^{st}$  8 matches, being 6 VPs behind the number 8 team.

#### 我們要改進的是:

- (1) 加強竟叫的判斷,如我們有局叫到必成的 4♥,對方從 1♠叫到 4♠,你總要以拿正分為主來考慮吧,除非你不會判斷,實戰結果叫 5♥下 1,另桌 4♠被加倍,二邊失分。
- (2) 改進隨手出牌習慣,第1墩牌稍為思考一下,不要太快出牌,把必成的2▲打宕。
- (3) 我們太多的 Slam 叫不到,而對方叫到的 Slam,在我這桌都是鐵牌。(另文用中國高手牌例說明)

### What we should improve are:

- (1) To strengthen our judgement in competitive bidding. If we have a game of 4♥ and the opponents bid from 1♠ to 4♠, you have to consider from the viewpoint of getting a positive score, unless you do not judge. In practice, we bid 5♥ down 1 while our teammates' 4♠ was doubled and went down. We lost scores at both tables.
- (2) To improve our habit of declarer play. We should think carefully before playing our 1<sup>st</sup> trick. Don't play too quickly. We have failed to make a cold 2.

(3) Our teammates have missed many slams while opponents could bid cold slams at my table (I would write another article using Chinese experts' boards as examples).






I sat South and had 4 points only. With matching, I can "overbid" 1 level more. (When I bid, I assumed that Partner had 5-carder  $\checkmark$ s). When you see the 4 hands, both  $4 \checkmark$ , and  $3 \checkmark$  can be made while  $4 \checkmark$  will go down 1. The loss was not great. I was afraid that if I responded  $2 \checkmark$ , Partner would think I had 8 points. So I bid 1 level more to show I had shape but no points.

The 1<sup>st</sup> lead was the ♠A, another ♠. As my ♠ suit could only discard 2 ♣s, it was not of much use. Due to entry problem, I played the ♠ A at trick 3, ruff a ♠, a ♥ to the ♥ K, (East's ♥J dropped), ruff another ♠, West's ♠K dropped, West's ♥A gained entry at trick 7. He has not read my cards correctly and he thought that Dummy's ♠s could discard my ♣ losers. So, he played ♣A and then another ♣, hoping that East had the ♣K. The result was very lucky. We won this board unexpectedly and won 14 IMP. This was a competition where the card-reading ability was not high.

如果我開叫 2♣,同伴應 2◆,我就有一個再叫問題,無論叫什麽,都不能準確描寫這副牌,我開叫 1◆,(唯一缺點,我們有 4▼或 4♠,同伴持 2 個有用的 Q,4 分牌,Pass 我的 1◆),不過橋牌未必《絕對》,即使這樣,還可能有人平衡叫牌。下面的叫牌很正常:

If I opened 2♣ and Partner responded 2♠, I would have a rebid problem. Whatever I would bid, I could not describe my hand accurately. I opened 1♠, (the only disadvantage was that we should have 4♥ or 4♠ but if Partner held 2 useful Qs and 4 HCP, he might pass my 1♠). However, nothing is "absolute" in bridge. Even so, an opponent might bid to balance.





In the long-term, the chance of the team which did not bid 7 to win wil be less than the chance to lose. I would write another article to introduce the biddings of some current champions. Perhaps, you would think that they do not know how to play bridge and do not know that your own bidding purely based on HCPs has already lagged behind the current "trend".

2012 年 8 月中,香港 VICO Team (有 Alan Sze, Abby Chiu 等) 和香港 SPARK Team (有 Bubble Ho, CC Mok)參加深圳吉利汽車夏季賽,我有機會參加 SPARK Team. 難得和青年橋友一起,他們比我們老年橋友犯錯少,我玩得也很開心,只可惜沒有和這次前 3 名遇上。最後 1 輪遇上這次第 4 名,我們 1 副大牌處理不好,就輸到 25VP。我一共打 5 場,3 勝 2 負,得 78VP,剛合格。第 5 場牌 10:00am 開始,我不能及時趕到,於是看樂林打牌(他是高手,隊中還有伍少紅名將,最後他的隊也只得第 10),他坐北,看了他的 2 副叫牌

In mid August 2012, Hong Kong VICO Team consisting of Alan Sze and Abby Chiu and Hong Kong SPARK Team consisting of CC Mok and Bubble Ho participated in the Geely Automobile Summer Competition 2012. I had the chance to join Hong Kong SPARK Team. It was rare for me to be able to play with young bridge friends. They committed less number of mistakes than our old bridge friends. I played very happily. It was a pity that I did not have the chance to meet the top 3 teams in the competition. In the last round, we met the team who became the 3<sup>rd</sup> runner-up. We did not handle an important board well and we lost 25 VPs. I have played 5 rounds in total – 3 wins and 2 losses and obtained 78 VPs, just passed. The 5<sup>th</sup> round started at 10 00 am. I was unable to arrive on time and so I watched Le Lin play (he is an expert. His team consisted of famous player - Wu Shao Hung. In the end, his team only came 10<sup>th</sup>). He sat North. I have watched his bidding for 2 boards:





After the  $2^{nd}$   $3 \spadesuit$ , I believed that Partner had stopper in  $\spadesuit$  and judged that West had 5-carder  $\spadesuit$ . If the  $\lor$  K was with East ( $\lor$ K was really held by East), then the contract could be made.



If the  $\blacktriangledown Q$  was changed to the  $\spadesuit Q$ , (then you would 1.5 stopper in  $\spadesuit$ ), the bidding of 3NT was more ideal. Now, you can only assume that West has the singleton  $\clubsuit K$  or East has the singleton  $\clubsuit J$ , (to win all  $\clubsuit S$ ,  $\clubsuit S$  have to be 3 - 1) before you can make 3NT.



- 2. I should have thought about the Partner had 2 Major suits. If he had only 1 ♥ suit, he could have bid 3♥ (F) after 2♣.
- 3. If he had fit for my ◆s, he could have cuebid 3♣. Therefore, after 4♣, I had no necessity to stress my ◆s.
- 4. There was a remedy. After 4. I could pass 1<sup>st</sup> and wait for Partner to balance. However, I wonder whether we would try slam afterwards.
- 5. If I bid 4 after 4., we must be able to stay at the best contact of 6...

A mistake in a board can cause a great difference in ranking. Now, I can only use it as an experience for the future. We have to learn lessons from continuous failures in order to improve.
