

# BBO 上看百慕達盃 Watching Bermuda Bowl on BBO

難得有機會在 BBO 上看世界盃賽事,我選擇看公開組,特別是轉播有中國隊參加的賽事。21 場預賽.,中國隊得 274.90IMP,名列第 2,相當不錯的成績。但在 8 進 4 的淘汰賽中,以 2IMP 之差,不敵美國 2 隊,很多人關心的第 95 牌,也就是最後第 2 副牌,如果你是東,持

It was a golden opportunity to be able to watch the competitions in the Bermuda Bowl on BBO. I chose to watch the Open Series, especially those competitions participated by China Team. From the 21 qualifying competitions, China Team obtained 274.90 IMPs and came 2<sup>nd</sup>, a very good result. However, in the knockout competition for eliminating 4 out of 8 teams, China Team lost by 2 IMPs to USA2 team.

Many people are very concerned about Board 95, the 2<sup>nd</sup> last board. If you are East, holding:


Judged from the bidding, South has 20-21 points, and North and South jointly have 26+ points. Your partner have at most 7 points. If you bid, what cards do you partner need to have in order for you to win 8 tricks? (If you win 8 tricks, doubled, - 500.) If you cannot win 8 tricks, it is better not to bid. I think most people holding East's hands would not bid. However, the actual bidding was:


The result was down 6. At the other table, South made 4♠+1. China team lost 13 IMPs for this board and lost the whole match. It was a great regret for the China team.

Of course, the defeat was not just due to this board only. For defense, there were also some errors in judgment or guesswork. An example can be taken from a board in the same match:

First lead the \$8, followed by the \$6, \$5 and \$Q. You cannot not see the \$A, \$3 and \$4. Will partner have a 2-carder \$\sigma\$ suit? This is what you want to know. As partner played the \$5, the chance of he having a 2-carder \$\sigma\$ suit is greater. At trick 2, Declarer played the \$5 what will you play? Let's analyze 1st.

莊家在沒有◆支持情形下,叫上 3NT,說明他全靠大牌牌力。不是依靠◆長套,如果他是單張◆,你上◆K,他只能得 1 墩,如果是 2 張◆(最多 2 張),你出◆K,他一定讓一墩,再回手出◆,才能得 2 墩。你擔心他要建立◆套嗎,前提是他手中有 4 張◆(也即同伴是單張◆5),你判斷像嗎?如果他手上有 2 張◆,4 張◆,或 1 張◆,3 張◆,或 2 張◆,3 張◆,你出◆K,都不吃虧,(前一種情形,一定能建立◆套,後 2 種情形,一定不能建立◆套)。唯一吃虧的是他持 1 張◆,4 張◆,他如想建立◆,是你出◆K 幫了他。

Without much support in ◆, Declarer bid 3NT, indicating that he was relying on HCPs and not on a long ◆ suit. If he has a singleton ◆ and if

you play the ♠K, he will have only 1 trick in ♠. If he has doubleton ♠ (at most 2 cards) and if you play the ♠K, he will duck 1<sup>st</sup> and then play the remaining ♠ when he gained entry again in order to have 2 tricks in ♠. Are you worrying that Declarer will establish the ♠ suit? The pre-condition is that he has a 4-carder ♣ suit (i.e., partner has a singleton ♣5), do you judge so? If he has a 2-carder ♠ suit and a 4-carder ♣, or a 1-carder ♠ suit and a 3-carder ♣ suit, or a 2- carder ♠ suit and a 4-carder ♣ suit, you will not suffer if you play the ♠K (in the 1<sup>st</sup> case, Declarer must be able to establish the ♠ suit, in the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> cases, Declarer cannot establish the ♠ suit). The only case that you will suffer is that Declarer holds a 1-carder ♠ suit and a 4-carder ♣ suit. If he wants to establish the ♠ suit, your ♠K will help him.

Based on the above analysis, it is better to play the ◆K. In reality, South played the ◆7, (East had gifted Declarer at least 1 card and it was the 9<sup>th</sup> trick that Declarer needed.) In the end, Declarer won 2 tricks in ♣, 2 tricks in ♠, and 2 tricks in ♠, and 3 tricks in ♥ and made the contract.

主打方面,也有不足之處,就拿這副牌來講,東西方的 3NT,要靠南出錯牌,才能成約。但 5◆是鐵牌,也不是每一個人都打成。因為另一桌中國隊東西

叫到 5◆, 首引 ◆ J, 第 2 墩 ◆ 5, 依次 ◆ 7, ◆ J, ◆ 2 贏到, 第 3 墩 ◆ A, 沒有考慮 ◆ 是 4-1 分配的情形。又飛不到 ◆, 結果下 1.

For declarer play, there was also deficiency. For this board, the making of 3NT is dependent on South's playing wrongly. However, 5 → is cold but not everyone can make it. The East and West players of China team ended in 5 →.

1<sup>st</sup> trick: ♠J

2<sup>nd</sup> trick: ♦5, followed by ♦7, ♦J and ♦2

3<sup>rd</sup> trick: ♦A.

West did not consider the distribution of ◆s being 4-1 and could not finesse ♣ successfully and the result was down 1.





所以說,對方打不成的 3NT,被打成,自己應該打成的 5◆,沒有打成。這副 牌輸 12IMP。如果 2 邊都做對,即打成 5◆,又打宕 3NT,將得 12IMP。一副

牌相差 24IMP。

3NT is not makeable but was made by USA2 Team. China Team should have made 5♦ but failed. China Team lost 12 IMPs. If both side did rightly, i.e., made 5♦ and defeated 3NT, China team should have won 12 IMPs. The net difference is 24 IMPs.

Meckstroth 判斷正確, ◆K, ◆Q 在南家, 他將吃♥, 將吃 ◆的計劃, 不會被 北超將吃, 在消去南的 ◆和♥後, 用 ◆投入南, 最後他成功了。在 BBO 上轉 播的 12 隊中, 有 3 隊叫到 5 ◆, 只有他完成定約。


Meckstroth judged rightly. The ◆K and the ◆Q were with South. His plan of ruffing of ♥ and ♠ would not be over-ruffed by North. After eliminating South's ♠s and ♥s, he used a ◆ to throw in South and finally succeeded. Among the 12 teams broadcast on BBO, 3 teams arrived at 5 ◆ but only Meckstroth made the contact.

# Forget convention

橋牌比賽中記錯約定的事,不是太多,出現在高手間,更是少見。也許是太 疲倦了,高手也有這種錯。2015年8月 Spingold 半决赛,有下面2 副牌

The number of occasions when players forget convention in bridge competitions are not many. It is of course rare to happen among expert bridge players. Expert players may commit this mistake as they get tired. The following 2 boards appeared in the semi-final competition of Spingold in August 2015:



一桌叫牌如下: The bidding at one table was as follows:

To deepen the preemption, East opened 4♣. He might have forgotten that he and his partner used Namyats and 4♣ meant a good ♥ suit., West did not expect that East would bid wrongly and so he responded 4♥. Though East discovered that he had bid wrongly, he could only rebid 5♣. The defending side won 1♣ trick, 2 ♦ tricks, 3 ♥ tricks (including one ruff). Down 4.







西的 3◆是問同伴,如果有◆檔張,請叫 3NT。東理解西是 2 套高花。如是 2 套高花,叫加倍不是更好。在西叫 5◆後,東理解西是 ◆ + ◆套再次在 ◆和 ◆中選 ◆套。

West's 3 ◆ was asking partner to bid 3NT if he had a ◆ stopper. East interpreted it as 2 major suits. If West is having 2 major suits, isn't it better for him to double? After West's 5 ♣ , East interpreted it as West having ♣ suit + ♥ suit and he chose the ♥ suit out of his ♣ and ♥ suits.

看 4 家牌, 3NT 是打不成, 實戰中, 很難做到那麼完美的防守。

If we look at all the four hands, 3NT is not makeable. However, in practice, it was difficult to have a perfect defense.
