- Adopted the change in M&A with regards to eligibility to represent China Hong Kong: The current practice is that anyone who have been a HKCBA ordinary member for consecutively 2 years and didn't represent other NBO in the past 2 years can represent China Hong Kong. However to protect the interest of local players HKCBA Council has decided to tighten the rules and add a condition to allow only those who have Hong Kong permanent residency to represent. HKCBA Council also have the sole discretion to decide on the handling of any special case.
- Due to the resignations of 2 council members (Arthur Lau and CC Wong), an election has been held to replace the 2 vacancies. Crystal Tang and Louis Tam were nominated and since there were no other nominations, both of them were automatically elected as council member for one year term (2016/2017).

#### 7 AOB:

- a) There was concern raised in the meeting with regards to registration deadline as some events seems to have deadline while some do not. An example is that the recent IMP Pairs event still accepted walk-in registration which delayed the start of the game. Tournament Operations advised that since the pre-registration system on the website is not well established yet therefore still accept walk-in registration. They will look into improvement.
- b) One member complaint that it is unfair for all players who participate in the Qualifying rounds of the trial to share the registration fee for the Finalists. Council advised that this is to follow WBF practice, and to encourage serious players to join the trial only.
- c) One member suggested adding more subsidiaries/affiliated associations to HKCBA so as to increase the funding from HKSAR government. Council advised that we will look into the pros and cons of this proposal.

First lead the  $\checkmark$ 3, followed by  $\checkmark$ K,  $\checkmark$ A and  $\checkmark$ 4.

Trick 2: South ♥8. I believe that most ordinary players will play ♥6. In reality, Declarer played the ♥J North ♥Q.

Trick 3: North return the ♥7, and gave Declarer chance to make 3NT.

In fact, North could not see the ▼T62. From what combination of ♥ that partner would return the ▼8. Obviously, Declarer's card was a deception card.

If Declarer followed ♥6 at Trick 2 North would not have returned a ♥at Trick 3 and the

3NT contract would most likely not be made. As Declarer fears that you would shift to another suit, so he plays a deception card. As a ♥ was returned at Trick 3, Declarer has already got 9 tricks. At Trick 4, he gifted a ♣ and he would get 4 ♣ tricks, 3 ♦ tricks and 2 ♥ tricks. In other words, he only lost 2 ♥ tricks, 1 ♠ tricks and 1 ♣ trick.




AK, and so due to communication problem, he could not establish the long A suit and had only 10 tricks, down 1... I think that only experts could not make the contract for this board. From the bidding, he judged that West had 6 times ♣, 4-5 times ♠, as he had followed with 2 ♥ cards, he should have only 0-1 cards in ♠. Perhaps, he judge by reference to probability that the AK must be in East's hand. When he played the ♠6, he hoped that East would consider that West had the ♠A. If East played a small ♠, he needed not guess the ♦s and he would have 11 tricks already. The 4 hands are:


# Elite Mind Games

今年 2 月。國際智力運動聯盟智力運動精英賽 2016 IMSA elite mind games 在中國舉行,除中國隊外,公開組邀請了波兰,瑞典,保加利亞三隊。女子組邀請了法國,英國,荷蘭三隊。4 個隊打雙循環,前 2 名再打 48 副牌,決定冠亞軍。最後公開組冠軍是波蘭隊,女子組是法國隊。讓我們來看一些精英們處理牌的方法。

In February 2016, International Mind Sports Association held the 2016 IMSA Elite Mind Games in China. With the exception of China team, Poland, Sweden and Bulgaria were invited to take part in the Open Series. For Ladies series, France, England and the Netherlands were invited. 4 teams played 2 round robins. The top 2 teams would play 48 boards to decide the champion and 1<sup>st</sup> runner-up. In the end, the champions of Open Series and Ladies Series were Poland team and French team respectively. Let us see how the treatments of elites.

South was too conservative. If he bid  $2 \checkmark$ , or passed partner's double, the result would be different. The reason was that North doubled in the direct position and so he had the strength of an opening hand. If South had one less Ace, or 2 less Aces, would he also just respond  $2 \clubsuit$ ? Only when North doubled in the balancing seat would South's  $2 \clubsuit$  be acceptable. In sum, there must be a problem if you just bid  $2 \clubsuit$  whether you had one Ace or two Aces. Even though  $2 \clubsuit +2 \textdegree$ , the Netherland's team still lost 11 IMPs.
