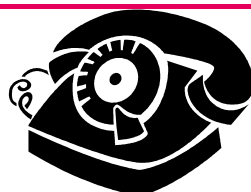

In Makati City's match against Japan-Lion, partner Albert Quiogue was faced with an opening lead on the auction of East-West of one notrump – three notrump, rather than opening with his deuce of hearts a suit so anemic from his fourth best, Quiogue deviated from the textbook opening lead of fourth best in notrump defense. He decided to lead from his spade hoping to hit partner's suit. This lead felled the contract. With my spades established, the queen of clubs was the entry to seen down the spades. This demonstrates why opening leads are of such importance and must be given a great deal of thoughts rather than an automatic action on fourth best leads.

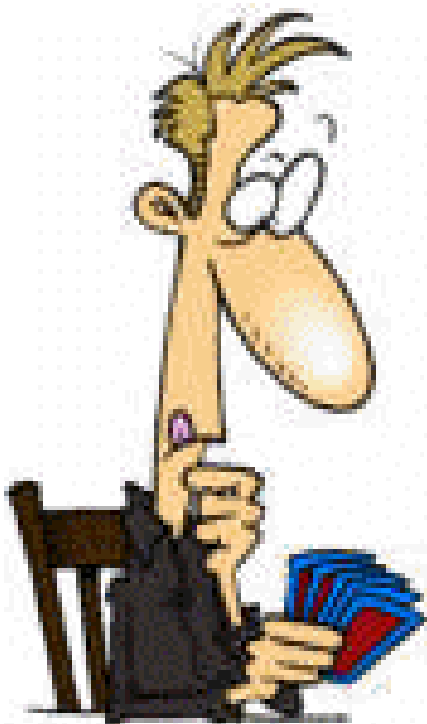

Li Ka Him actually knows that Tiffany has 6/7 spades, minimum opening but slam interest with ♠A and ♣K. She has not got the ♣Q, so she has to hold the ♠K.

With CAJT5 he can now bid 7♣

North leads the HK, which means that he is (very) likely to hold the ♣Q. So ♥A, ♣A, ♣J, ♣K, ♠A, ♠K, marked spade finesse and \$\$\$\$\$\$!
