TOURNAMENT DIRECTOR'S STATEMENT OF FACTS AND RULING :

When West asked South what is meaning of North 4D opening at her turn, South replied that is weak.

On NS's convention card, 4D opening is Nammyats, East claimed that if he knows that 4D opening is weak instead he would not double.

As there is no misexplanation of North's 4D bid and East should call the director if he wants to change his call before his partner has bid. There fore the score stands.

LAW REFERENCES : 21131, 75, 40

SUPPLEMENTARY STATEMENT BY PLAYER :

MORIMOTO(E) said that West bid 4H after asking the meaning of 4D (South said 4D mean D suit weak hand). In convention card 4D is Nammyats, East saw the card so he decided to double, surprisingly when West asked the meaning again, South answered that it was weak D, if East knows 4D was D, he didn't double.

Decision of the Appeal Committee ;
There is no damage to EW, score STANDS, but there is discrepancy between the explanation and convention card, there will be 3 Imp procedural penalty to NS only, the VP shall change accordingly, deposit forfeited.

Board 20, Shanghai JH nicely stopped in 4S made, SARA Open Room landed in 5S – 1 after RKCB sequence, 12 imp to Shanghai JH, SARA – Shanghai JH 0 – 18 Imp.

Board 21, another partscore swing 7 Imp for Shanghai JH, Closed Room they made 2S, Open Room SARA landed in 4C went down 2, now 0 – 25 Imp.

Board 22, first 1 Imp to SARA, Open Room they made 11 tricks in 4H, Closed Room Shanghai JH only 10 tricks, 1 – 25 Imp.

Board 27, Shanghai JH gained 2 Imp, Closed Room they made 2H, Open Room they were in 3D – 1, now 18 – 42 Imp.

Board 28, pushed, both EW pairs bid and made 4S.

Board 29, SARA got 1 Imp from the best DA lead by Teramoto, 2H just made, other room 2H + 1, now 19 – 42 Imp.

Board 30, SARA got back 9 Imp, Closed Room they made 11 tricks in 4H, Open Room they allowed to play 3S – 1, running score 28 – 42 Imp.

Good 4NT bid J. Yeh in Open Room, so EW already lost a lot of space to negotiate for a grand, actually 7H is always make if declare by West. Closed Room more conservative, only 2NT from North, but 7C is very good save against 6H, when opponent pushed to 7H and you have a void, you have to make a Lightner Double and hope partner will lead your void, this time 7H was on the wrong hand to play, but with D 3 lead, easy to bring it home, without this double JETOX gained 13 Imp instead of 13 Imp lost, a lot of Imp swing, 26 Imp due to fail to double.

イーストのハンズは9点だけだ。点数からかんがえば9点ではオープンはならない。点数はたりないので3♦ビッドのハンズだとおもう人もいる。

このようなハンズはいろんな意見が出られる。上記の点数依存者の以外に、3♣♦♥♠のようなオープンリングは絶対ほかのスーツに4枚もあることは許さない考えも、健在。

あなたはどっちですか。

なんと言っても、上記の二つが、もう有名ではなくなる。

シェープがいいので9点でもいいから1♦をすとか。同様、7枚♦のことだから普通に3♦をビッドするけど、4♦か5♦までビッドしてスウィングをワザと作る人は多くなっている。あなたには5♦のような大胆的なビッドどこまで受け取れるでしょうか。



もう一つのタイプがある、オープンとパスの間にあり、メジャーですかマイナーですかこれで判断する。メジャーであれば1レベルでもいい4レベルでも平気。マイナーであれば物事をすべて忘れる。おれはこの変形タイプだ。

広州 対 インドの対戦ですが、みんな1♦をオープンした。現代のブリッジはもうそうになっている。おかしくはない。理解できるはず。

あなたはどのタイプでもいいんだけど、現実には、みんな、昔よりもっとビッドをするわけです。昔は、13点以上ではなければ、1はオープンしない頑固グループがあったけど、最近は7点でも1オープンするコンベンションも誕生していた。理由はただひとつ、みんなもっとビッドするよ。

でも、それをすれば、いい成績がきつと取れるとはぜんぜん言えない。

知るはずのものはほかの人はどうやってブリッジをすることだ。ほかの人の考えを把握することは大切だと私は思う。

みんな1♦から5♦までビッドすることを知ることが重要。結局あなたはどうかあなた次第です。先生の意見を聞くとか、自分のブリッジのスタイルを明白するとか。最後に、自分の立場は創立しなければならない。

かわいそうな人は、立場のない人だ。このハンズはパスをしてゲームをミスすると、次のハンズは同じだったらオープンをしてしまう。もちろん、このハンズをオープンしてダブルされてダウンすると、次は絶対パスする考えになってしまう、こともこわい。

あなたのやり方で負けると、自分に‘負けたね、研究になるぞ、次はこのようなハンズがあったらもっと注意をしておなじのやり方でまた負けるか勝ち戻すか自分のため詳しい統計を作る、統計により将来のやり方が変わっても後悔はしない’と言ったほうが良いと思う。

現代のブリッジはみんなもっとビッドするように見えるのであなたもそうしたい気があれば全然大丈夫です。でも、ちゃんと考えてください。変わるか変わらないかちゃんと覚悟してください。もし自分を変えると決まったら、すぐ再度変えることは望ましくない。おれたちは人間だよ、飛んでいる羽ではない。





Be a consistent player

(I hope especially youth player will spend a minute to read this.)

We have finished day 1 and day 2, how did you do?

Intercity is the biggest event in Hong Kong. It is our pleasure to be able to invite so many strong teams to get involved. I hope the tournament will continue to go well.

The bidding, declarer play and defense in Intercity is the most top level among local tournaments. You will always get surprised about the great performance from others.

Have you found that your play somehow has changed throughout the tournament? Probably you might find yourself have learnt a lot from Intercity. You might plan to change your play. Changing is good or not? I am not sure. Many just do not know what to do, after seeing great action from others? Follow or not? There is no answer.

Well, here is a hand from Intercity.

Lets see East's hand, only 9 points. From the point of view of point range, 1♦ open is not reasonable. You could bid 3♦ to show 7 cards of diamonds, but some people do not love to preempt with a 4-card side suit, ie clubs. You might pass, of course.

Currently people will tend to bid high all the time with a hand of good shape. This cannot be explained as overbidding, but sometimes could be contradiction with point range consideration.

People who love the shape bid 4♦/5♦! If you bid like this, the possibility of a swing score will become bigger. Many people love to create swings, which were wished to be positive.



There is a strange type of people who consider this hand as the middle between open and pass. In this case, all is depended on the long suit itself. If it is a major suit, 1 level to 4 level opening is ok. If it is a minor suit, control self and pass. I am this strange type.

Anyway what would you bid with East hand?

The hand comes from a open team match between China and India. They all opened 1♦. In modern bridge world, people bid more aggressively then before. 1♦ is understandable.

In the past people were relatively conservative. Some stubborn people even never open a hand without 13 points. Today, people bid aggressively, conventions start with 7 points + for 1 level opening born.

Aggressive bidding will result in better score? No idea.

I think it is important to know what others are doing and how they are thinking. To understand each others always win. For example, with this sort of hand, you should prepare yourself that some people will pass, some will call 1, some will open 5, and how it will give an effect to the bidding auction.

Finally, you should create your own style and maintain it.

People with no style/direction are poor. I suggest that you ask your favourite teachers for opinions, or simply set your own regarding to your experience. Anyway, you'd better confirm your own playing methods and maintain them.

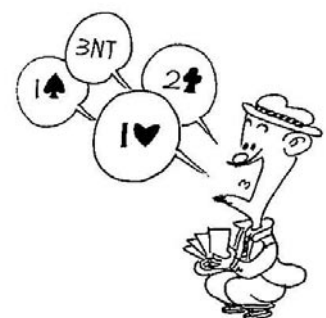
If you pass this hand, miss a game, and then call a level with the same hand later on, your play will be inconsistent. Similarly, if you call a level, got doubled, down, and then pass later on with the same hand, you will not know what you are doing any more.

In above cases, you are not sure how to win the game at all, I am sure. At least, you do not have confidence to win. In this way, can you expect any good score?

Here is my suggestion. When you lose at the end, review it at dinner time, and create your own statistics for the action. You need to repeat the same things many times to construct a reasonably big statistics, in order to tell yourself what is right or wrong. In future, if you change yourself regarding to the experience, there is no regret.

If you decide to follow the trend of modern bridge – more aggressive approach, it is fine to make your change. However, you cannot just change yourself again due to one losing board.

A lot of things can be discussed with this hand, give me a chance to continue the sweet talk later, if I will have not already written too much.
