### MINUTES OF THE TENTH COUNCIL MEETING

Date & Time : 17<sup>th</sup> December 1997 at 6:30 P.M.

#### ACTION

1. The minutes of the last meeting were read and adopted with the following amendments:

Under paragraph I (d), the name 'Lillian Yeung' should read as 'Lillienne Yeung'.

Under paragraph I (e) the word 'both' should read 'bath'.

2. Matters Arising from last minutes

Still awaiting finalization of accounts regarding the PABF Championships 1997 and ICBC Intercity 1997. CC

AC would have to undertake the computer programme himself. This would be done before the AGM AC

JM to follow up on Sir David Trench Fund JM

DZ had arranged for Lillienne Yeung to join the HKCBA

CB had spoken to Imran Gardezi

SW had prepared the announcement regarding the PABF Championships 1998

AC and WH had revised the tournament schedule for 1998

3. Progress on Various Matters

(a) PABF Championships 1998

AC reported (i) that this would be held from 15<sup>th</sup>-24<sup>th</sup> May in Kobe;

(ii) the entry fee was US\$500 per team and US\$200 for the Youth; (iii) the deadline for submission of names (+photos) and convention cards was 20/3 and 15/4 respectively; (iv) the cost of the hotel was 18,000

Yen per night for a double room and 12,000 Yen for a single room; (v)

6 teams were participating in the trials for the Open (Ben. Kwok, Irene Ho, HW Wong, Ashley Lung, S Wong + Samme Lee) and there were 6 Youth Pairs, But no Ladies Teams. The Trials were underway and would be finished by the end of January.

(b) HK-Shanghai Interport

This had been held on 29<sup>th</sup> & 30<sup>th</sup> October 1997 in Shanghai. The Shanghai Team had won by a narrow margin, using the combined result of the Open and Lades team. In the pairs event, Karic Chiu and Lu Chin and Terence Tung and Anthony Fong had come 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> respectively in the c.w position.

Terence Tung had indicated that he was prepared to continue sponsorship of this event. However, if any member was interested in sponsorship of this event, they should contact DZ.

(c) Venue

CB reported that she and AL had hired a part-time maid to clean the premises, with noticeable improvement. AGREED that IH to sell off the bigger tables in the Clubhouse. IH

(d) Preparation for the AGM

This would be held on either 23<sup>rd</sup> or 24<sup>th</sup> or 27<sup>th</sup> February, 1998 depending on the availability of either the Mariners Club or the Chung Ngan Club. IH to arrange booking of venue. The meeting would begin at 6:30 pm promptly. IH

Noted that the Chairman and Treasurer's reports should be finalized before DZ/CC the next Council Meeting.

CB would prepare the appropriate notice after the venue had been booked. CB

SW to prepare and up-to-date list of Special Voting Members. SW

The following persons were nominated as Special Voting Member: Amy Yeung, Mario Yeung and Samuel Wan. Anyone wishing to nominate further Special Voting Members to contact DZ.

AGREED (i) that in view of their departure from HK, CB should write to Anthony Chow, Lesley Sung, Sophia Chok & WY Sit advising that their names would be removed from the list of Special Voting

Members, Subject to reinstatement upon their return to HK; (ii) DZ would contact Raymond Chow regarding guests to officiate at the

prize-giving; and (iii) SW to be responsible for ensuring the due return of the cups and trophies before the AGM. CB DZ SW

4. A.O.B.

(a) Tournament Schedule for 1998

The proposed schedule was tabled for discussion. After some minor

changes, the same was approved. Noted that the last 6 months of the the schedule was tentative, and therefore subject to change.

(b) Tournament Fees for 1998

AGREED that these would remain the same.

(c) The Guangzhou-HongKong-Macau Triangular Interport

Noted that this would be held in HK in July 1998 just before the Intercity. The teams coming 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> in the Intercity Trials will represent HK at this event.

(d) Intercity 1998

This was scheduled to take place from 22<sup>nd</sup>-27<sup>th</sup> July 1998 immediately following the Guangzhou-HongKong-Macau Triangular Interport and the HK-Shanghai Interport.

Regarding venue, AC reported that he had received quotations from both the Harbour Plaza (Hungom) and the Regal Kowloon. The rates were \$950 net for a single(court view ) (or \$1,250 for a harbour view) at the Plaza and \$888 (net) for a single at the Regal. Cost of banqueting was also discussed, as was the location of both hotels.

AGREED that the venue should be the Regal Kowloon, subject to further negotiation by AC.

Invitations would be sent out after Chinese New Year. AC also reported he was currently negotiating a group fare with Cathay Pacific.

5. Date of Nest Meeting

The next council Meeting will be held on Wednesday, 14<sup>th</sup> January 1998 at 6:30 p.m.

There being no other business, the meeting adjourned at 8:15 pm.

Steps were being taken to ensure the return of the cups and trophies before the AGM.

3. Progress on Various Matters

(a) Intercity 1998

AC tabled a detailed proposal he had prepared in respect of the forthcoming Intercity championships covering date, venue, organization and budget. In particular it was noted that (i) the dates will now be 29<sup>th</sup> July - 2 August 1998 to avoid a clash with require sponsorship in the region of \$95,000 to break even.

Venue was discussed, the two possibilities being either the Regal Kowloon or the Harbour Plaza in Hung Hom. After Discussing the relative merits of each, it was AGREED that the Intercity should be held at the Harbour Plaza.

(b) PABF Championships 1998

Noted that the first two teams in the trials for the Open Were Ben Kwok & Ashley Lung's teams, 8 pairs had entered the Youth Trials. There was no entry in the Ladies' section.

(e) Tournament Results for 1997

Noted that due to a breakdown in communications between AC and the directors, we did not have all the results for 1997 available.

AGREED (i) to implement a new scheme whereby we would maintain a 'results' file in the Clubhouse, with each director filing the results of the tournament he was responsible for; (ii) that IH be assigned to collate the tournament results for 1997 from all sources; (iii) CC to calculate the respective master points and gold points for each member based on the 1997 results.

The entry fees for the trials will be the regular tournament fees.

All confirmed teams must pay the Inter-city entry fees on or before 26 June 1998. In addition, the confirmed teams are entitled to a package deal on the Open Pairs(3 pairs), IMP Pairs(3 pairs) and Swiss Team(1 team) at HK\$1,880 if they register and pay on or before 26 June 1998.

Incentives

- The top 2 local pairs in the IMP Pairs event from both directions will receive free entries into all regular HKCBA IMP Pairs games for the rest of 1998.
- The top 2 local pairs in the Open Pairs final event will receive free entries into all regular HKCBA pairs games for the rest of 1998.
- The local pairs who take part in both the IMP Pairs and the Open Pairs events will receive a free entry to 1 regular HKCBA pairs event in 1998. A senior pair will receive an additional free entry under the same conditions.

Special Package for Student Members

Team Championship-21<sup>st</sup>-22<sup>nd</sup> June, 1997**

Thank you for your letter dated 12<sup>th</sup> June, 1997 The contents of which have been duly noted.

As you know, the announcement inviting teams to participate in this event was circulated to members in mid-March, the closing date for entries being 31<sup>st</sup> May, 1997. The maximum number of entries permitted was four. At our council meeting on 26<sup>th</sup> May, 1997, it was noted that only 5 entries had been received.

As the tournament was being held on 21<sup>st</sup> June, the Association faced severe time constraints in organizing trials for the selection of the teams to participate in this

tournament. Accordingly, the Association decided upon a selection policy which it felt was the most equitable to all members in the circumstances. This policy took into account both merit (i.e. no of master points gained over recent months) and active participation in Association tournaments.

However, by the closing date, unexpectedly a total of 8 teams registered and hence rendered the original decision on selection criterion rather odd. We apologize for not able to foresee such outcome.

Regarding your comments as to the adoption of those criterion for future tournaments, please be assured that we will do our utmost in the future to organize trials for the selection of teams to participate in overseas events.

**Re: 28<sup>th</sup> Djarum International Bridge Championship**

Thank you for your letter of 25<sup>th</sup> Feb 98. This letter serves to clarify a no. of your concerns.

First, it is clear that your team has followed the prescribed procedure in this matter while the Council has not done so. I do not wish to explain in detail why a communication problem arose, save to say that this is a problem that the Council will address seriously in future.

Regarding our policy to select a team to represent HK, In general, where more than 1 team registers, a trial will be held and the winners will normally be approved as the representing team. In the case of only 1 team registering, or, an invitation coming at very short notice, the council will 'appoint' a team. When 'appointing', the policy is to look for members of known calibre and good track record, normally grand, or life masters with no controversial behavior,. Failing to find such a team, the Council will decline the invitation.

Djarum is an annual event where the HK team is held in high esteem, seeded, given VIP treatment etc. and expected to do well. While we appreciate your team Oriental Oscar has done very well at local events, we did not believe that the nominated members had sufficient Grand, Life masters, or proven track record, hence the decision not to 'appoint' you as the 'national' team.
