

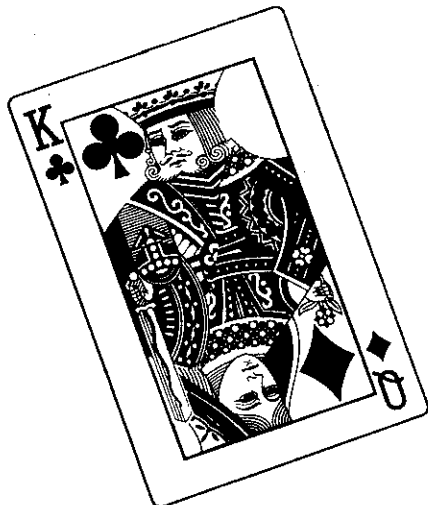

1. Minutes of the Last Meeting
The minutes of the last meeting was read and adopted. ACTION
2. Matters arising from the minutes of the last meeting
SW had not prepared the minutes of the last AGM. SW
- 3a. Venice Cup :
The Hong Kong team won 3 matches out of the 19 played. The overall raking after the qualifying round was 18 out of 20 teams. Ashley Lung would submit the captain's report when he was back to Hong Kong. DZ
- 3b. PABC 2000 :
Deadline for registration for trial of PABC 2000 would be end of February.
- 3c. Intercity 2000 :
The tournament would be held from 2 August to 6 August. Two venues, namely the Regal Kowloon Hotel and the Miramar Hotel, were under final consideration.
- 3d. The 11th World Bridge Teams Olympiad :
CW would issue notice to members inviting representatives for the tournament. Selection trial might be held if there was more the one entry. The normal fee of \$400 per session per team would be charged for trial. The Association would pay for the registration fee for the representative team. CW
- 3e. Finance
SW reported that the accounts for 1999 were under preparation and he estimated that there would be a loss of approximately \$50,000.
- 3f. Roster for Paul Jones Duplicate Pairs
KC instead of AC served for January. SK would serve for February.
- 3g. Membership and Attendance of Tournaments
SW reported that the number members for 1999 was 345. However, he pointed out that the number of student members was not small and from past experience these members were more likely to discontinue their membership than other groups. It was resolved that the target of members for 2000 would be 350. SK
SW also reported that up to the moment there wer 155 members including

life members.

3h. AGM preparation :

SW would prepare the minutes of last meeting and treasurer's report. CC would prepare the agenda. DZ would prepare chairman's report. CW would send the aforesaid documents to members. DZ would invite guests of prize presentation. DZ/CC SW/CW

It was resolved that DC and Laurence Lo were to be added to the list of special voting members.

3i. Ladder Team play-off Incidence:

SW reported that the winning team had a player never played during the qualifying rounds. After discussion, it was resolved that the result of the final play-off stood.

4. A.O.B.

a. Registration as voter :

It was resolved that the association should register as voter for the forthcoming election. CC would follow up the matter.

b. Club House of Hong Kong University Alumni :

The council was asked if the association was interested of using the club house of the Alumni which could serve approximately 24 mahjong tables. SK would follow up and report to the members. CC SK

c. World simultaneous pairs :

Two tournaments would be held on 22 and 23 August 2000 in addition to the world wide simultaneous bridge contest to be held on 2 and 3 June 2000. The council would discuss the matter again when details were received.

d. Handbook review committee :

It was resolved that AC would the committee with members BT and CC. The committee would review the present handbook and see if any updating was necessary.

e. Appointment of Honorary President :

It was resolved that MR Patrick Choy be appointed as Honorary President of the association for a term of three years from 2000. Mr Choy would assist in acquiring club house for the association.

6. Date of Next Meeting

The date of next meeting would be on 21 February 2000 at the same venue. There being no other business and the meeting was adjourned at 7:45 p.m.

1. Minutes of the Last Meeting
 The minutes of the last meeting was read and adopted.
2. Matters arising from the minutes of the last meeting
 The Annual General Meeting was held on 29 February 2000. Unfortunately DZ was unable to arrange a guest star for the prize presentation.
3. It was agreed that 2 out of 4 of the officer bearers must sign in order to operate the major accounts of the association. The Hon. Treasurer must be notified in due course. It was further agreed that either the Chairman or the Hon. Treasurer must sign in order to operate the short-term account.
4. It was agreed to register the association as a voter for the legco election and the Chairman was authorised to represent the association to vote.

ACTION

5. The objectives and set up of the sub-committees and secretariat were agreed as per Attachment 1.
6. It was agreed that the association's telephone number, 26413666, would remain with Dr. Kenny Lau for another year. Dr. Lau subsequently agreed.
7. It was resolved that the winners and 1st runners-up of the Open Team of 4 would represent Hong Kong in this year's Guangzhou/Hong Kong/Macau interport. BT would notify the teams.
BT
Shanghai Contract Bridge Association was asking when we would send the teams to participate in the Shanghai/Hong Kong interport deferred from last year. It was agreed that we would look for a sponsor for the event. AC would tell Shanghai the situation and we will send a team only if a sponsor is found. AC
8. It was agreed that we would produce 4 issues of the Bridgzette this year with the next issue in April. We would plan to include all announcements in the Bridgzette in advance to minimise mailing costs for the announcements. We would also try to minimise mailing for the Bridgzette, where possible.
9. AL would start distributing the 1999 prize points on 14 March 2000 during the regular tournaments, as soon as the list was obtained from Steve Wong. The TDs would distribute on AL's behalf in his absence. The final date for distribution would be 30 June 2000. AL
10. The equipment of the association was scattered at the tournament venue and at Irene Ho's office. There had been no up to date record of the status. S. S. Bux and the TDs would perform a physical check and report the status at the next meeting. SS
11. Progress
- a. Venice Cup Captain's Report:
The report from Ashley Lung was read and adopted. The Council gave a vote of thanks to AL for the job well done.
- b. Participating in the PABC 2000:
Only 1 open team (Cheung Lik, D. Xie, C. K. Poon, Hon Wing Kai, Ngau Wai Kei and Michael Lam) registered. No trial would be needed and it was agreed that approval be given for this team to participate. AC proposed to encourage more teams to participate and he would ask Patrick Choy the implications for the lack of participation from our association. AC
- c. Participation in the 11th World Bridge Olympiad:
The association would pay the entry fees for both open and ladies teams. We would only pay the entry fees for the senior team if there would be a trial. AC would contact WBF to clarify whether the accommodation package for the university team would apply to the NPC as well. AC
It was agreed that the Council would try to source subsidy for the participating teams. AC, BK and PP would look into the matter and AC/BK

- d. Inter-city 2000:
It was agreed to choose Hotel Miramar as the venue. S. S. Bux would negotiate with the hotel for a better deal. The inter-city organising committee would meet and report progress at the next meeting. SS
- e. Finance, Membership & Attendance:
As the books had not been transferred, AL would look into the matter and report in the next meeting. AL
- f. Roster for Paul Jones Duplicate:
S.S. Bux suggested that the active TDs should get more practice as players and he would roster them for Paul Jones. SS
12. A.O.B
- a. The Association's Name & Logo:
It was noted that the association was officially registered as "Hong Kong Contract Bridge Association" and it was resolved that this name would be used in future. It was resolved that the round logo would be the association's official logo. We would probably look for a new design next year for the 50th anniversary.
- b. Sports Federation & Olympic Committee:
It was resolved that S. S. Bux would represent the association in all communications with and meetings at the Sports Federation & Olympic Committee of Hong Kong, China, and the Sports Promotion Office. AC would write to the respective bodies to advise the status. AC
- c. World Wide Bridge Contests:
The 2 World Wide Bridge Contests were added to the tournament schedule.
- d. WBF Code of Practice & WBF System Policy 2000:
It was agreed that these documents be adopted by the association where appropriate. The documents would be posted on our web site for members' reference.
- e. Laser Printer:
Our members were complaining about the slow speed of the existing printer at the tournament venue. It was agreed that a laser printer costing around \$2,500 be purchased and set up by 1 April 2000.
13. Date of Next Meeting
It was agreed that the council meeting be held on the 2nd Thursday of the month (or the 3rd Thursday if the 2nd Thursday is a holiday). The date of the next meeting would be 13 April 2000.
There being no other business and the meeting was adjourned at 9:45p.m.

今年1月7日-21日在百慕大舉行的世界橋牌錦標賽公開組的前三名為美國 I 隊，巴西隊，美國 II 隊。女子組的前三名為荷蘭隊，美國 I 隊，丹麥隊。

Bermuda held the 50th World Championship from 7/1/2000--21/1/2000. The best teams in order were: In the open series, USA I, Brazil and USA II; in the ladies: Holland, USA I and Denmark.

女子組決賽，荷蘭隊以 249.75 比 249.25 勝美國隊。其實直到大螢幕播出最後一副牌時，美國隊坐南的 Molson 的首攻，還能影響冠軍誰屬。當時她持 ♠K863 ♥J9876 ♦98 ♣52，叫牌是：應首攻那一張？

Holland's ladies overcoming the USA by 1/2 an IMP, 249.75 to 249.25.

This was the last board on the Vu-graph, Molson of USA was on lead, little knowing she was deciding who the champions would be:

She was holding: ♠K863 ♥J9876 ♦98 ♣52 and on this bidding:

Somehow no one doubled. HA was led and continued. Declarer drew 2 trumps ending in dummy, Spade; West took 2 Spade tricks then D2, 5, Q, A. A top Diamond would have ended the proceedings but declarer Sokolow was Perhaps still groping after partner's 4NT played D3 from dummy and 7 from hand, 4 off and gained 1 IMP as 4H was made.

我們大家關心的中國隊成績不理想。中國在公開組的成績 20 隊中名列 16，比賽 19 場的 VP 為 250，平均每場僅 13.2。中國女子隊的成績 20 隊中名列第 7，得 VP328.5，平均每場得 17.3 應算不錯了，可惜半準決賽第一場對荷蘭隊，也即後來的冠軍隊，結果以相差 26IMP 失敗（其中 16 IMP 係荷蘭隊所帶的 IMP）。當然失敗了很可惜，另一方面，如果仔細檢查一下自己的不

足之處，也未嘗不是一件好事。我們從一些資料中比較一下中國女隊還需改進的牌例：

Both Chinese teams did not fare well. The men finished 16th out of 20 teams, 250 VPs in 19 matches or 13.2 in each. The ladies had 17.3 per match, 7th, unfortunately they met with Holland, the eventual winners, immediately in the knockout quarter-finals and lost 26 IMPs, 16 of those IMPs were carry-over.

Re-cap and analysis of out match records are important for future. Here we will see some hands are played by the Chinese Ladies Team.

2S was weak, Spade and a minor, a tactic against weaker teams perhaps. Yet neither the shape nor suit quality was anything recommendable to me: partner would likely assess incorrectly on the Spade and Q, 9 in Hearts is respectable support for an unpassed partner should she have a respectable suit as in this hand.

Sure enough, Egypt stopped in 2H where 4 is there for the taking. Over-eagerness often make a better team look silly.

Stansby's key bid 5NT requested partner to choose a slam, implying a not so strong trump suit. This information enabled Martel picking up the best spot, illustrating why and how they were one of the best and longest standing partnerships in the world.
