PABF Teams Registration

i. The names of the teams are as follows: Open: Henry Lam (NPC), Samuel Wan, Derek Zen, Peter Yeung, Alan Sze, KL Choy, Thomas Ng Ladies: Stephen Kwok (NPC), Shirley Chang, Amy Yeung, Monica Chan, LL Lee, Flora Wong, Ella Graca Youth: SS Bux (NPC), Laurance Lo (Manager), LH Chin, YC Lai, Yau Ngai, WK Lai, Arsene Yiu, Alick Ng

- ii. The tournament fee would be paid by HKCBA at the tournament.
- iii. Subsidy for youth team would include the air ticket and 1/3 of the hotel accommodation fee. If it ended in top 2 positions, excluding New Zealand and Australia), total accommodation fee would be subsidized. The hotel accommodation fee and air ticket will be fully subsidized for the Non-Playing Captain and the manager of the youth team.
- Open team has not submitted the complete training schedule, SB sewould follow-up.
- v. Training schedule for Ladies Team is as follows: From February to March: one practice session for every two weeks. From April to May: one practice session per week. Apart from that, 4 members will play Ladder Team, others will play at least 1 side game per month. They will play the Open Team of 4 if possible.
- vi. Training schedule for Youth Team is as follows:
 From February to May: There will be 2 Sunday training session from the afternoon to the evening per month, which include 2 hours of lecture, 1 hour of quiz and 5 hours of non-stop practice. The practice will tentatively be held in Mariners' Club, costing \$600 a day. In addition, Team A will have a weekly practice session.
- vii. It was confirmed that the hotel booking for the PABF would go through Mr. Ringo Lee instead of the SCBA.
- b. 50th Anniversary Inter-city
 There was no progress on this issue.
- c. Financial situation, membership and tournament attendance
- i. The attendance for January was better than that of latter half of last year. However, the response for Special Team was quite low. It was suggested that if attendance for Special Team keep falling, Conference Room instead of Main Hall would be booked to reduce cost.
- ii. Currently, there are 47 ordinary members, 7 senior members, 26 student members and 92 life members.
- iii. \$42000 prize points would be given out by Alfred Lung for the year 2000. The increase from \$37940 of the year 1999 is mainly due to rebate for Special Pairs.
- d. Update status on club premises
- i. A large scale promotion activity would be jointly organized with LCSD. The opening ceremony will be on 19th May 2001 at Tsing Yi, promotion will be held at other districts also.
- ii. LCSD would organize bridge beginners course at different districts. Instructors will be paid at standard rate. BK would contact and BK/LL arrange with LCSD for the course, with the help of Flora Wong and LL.

2000年"中國盃"(5th China Cup) China Cup-2000

2000年12月12日-18日在北京舉行中國盃國際橋牌精英賽 這次取消女子組,只設公開組 比賽共16隊參加,除中國9個隊外,其餘7個隊是(1)Hackett 家庭,再加上挪威新星 Geir Helgemo 其搭擋為95年代表美國參加百慕大盃的 Mark Lair。(2)楊小燕隊,(3)Bobby Wolff隊,(4)印尼隊,(5)荷蘭隊,(6)日本隊,(7)Patrick Choy 隊,成員包括大家熟悉的Samuel Wan, Karic Chiu, Lu Qin 等。比賽分二組,每組8隊,各組先進行單循環,小組前二名進入半決賽。經過7輪循環結果 Hackett 隊,荷蘭隊獲得A組首二名,B組前二名為中國女隊及聶衛平(Nie Wei Ping),潘開健(Pan Kai Jian),王為民(Wang Wei Min),庄則軍(Zhuang Ze Jun),徐紅軍(Xu Hong Jun)組成的國賓酒店隊。

在預客中,下面一副牌,使荷蘭隊積分超過中國隊進入決審。

This was the 5th China Cup held in Beijing, from 12th to 18th December, 2000. There was a slight change in format, cancelling the Ladies Event but increased the Open one to 16 teams, 9 from China and 7 international ones:- The Hacketts plus Geir Helgemo-Mark Lair, a Norwegian-USA pro-combination; Kathy Wei-sanders Team of basically USA Ladies National; Bobby Wolff's; Indonesian National Team; Netherlands National Team; Japan National Team; Patrick Choy's Ambassadors with HK's Samuel Nan, Karic Chiu, Lu Qin, etc. There were 2 sections of 8 teams in the Preliminaries, only the first 2 teams advancing. After 7 rounds, The Hackettes and Holland National finished tops in A while the China National Ladies Team and The Ambassador Hotel Invitational Team, of mainly veteran Chinese National Team qualified in B section.

This hand enabled the Dutch to defeat the Hacketts in the preliminaries to qualify, overtaking China, quite desperately:-

I think Li's line was incorrect, after the 2NT for minors and 4S(X), the distribution should be quite clear, the 10 tricks should comprise of I round of trump,

2 top Clubs, 2 Heart ruffs in dummy and 1 Diamond and 1 Club in hand, the IIA and lastly K,10 of trumps, so exiting the DJ after winning the 1st or 2nd round Heart was vital. Bidding in the other room:

A Club was led against Helgemo, Jack won, and laid a Diamond to West's Q, a Club was continued to dummy's ace and Spade to declarer's Q, who played another Diamond, West put up Ace to crush partner's King, Heart switch eventually or belatedly as Helgemo could return hand with SA to cash CK and D9 before throwing East in with Heart to give the last 2 tricks in Spades in dummy. Had West not given away the Club and then Diamond trick, it is hard to get 9 tricks with the communication problem, Li-Sue was the youngest pair, 32 years of age, engineers, in the newly formed national squad.

In the same hand, 4S was also difficult with repeated trump leads.

第三屆國際奧委會橋牌大獎賽 The 3rd International Olympic Committee Teams

審事於 2000年 10 月 30 — 11 月 3 日在瑞士洛縣 (Lausanne)舉行,像上一屆一樣,共有 6 隊被邀參加公開組,他們是中國,法國,印尼,意大利,波蘭,美國。預賽打單循環, 24 副牌,半決賽打 36 副牌,決賽打 64 副,預賽美國第一,選擇印尼為對手。結果半決賽美國以 50:65IMP 輸給印尼,意大利以 81.5:71 戰勝波蘭。決賽中美國以 56:52 勝波蘭獲第三,印尼隊以 124:119 勝意大利得冠軍。中國隊第五,法國隊第六。

女子組舉行 8 人賽,歐洲隊 (德國,法國,挪威,荷蘭各一對選手),以 407:402 勝北美洲隊 (三隊美國選手加一隊加拿大選手)。印尼隊是三員老將 (都已超過 53 歲),加上新秀 Karwur (只有 35 歲),我們試看他們在決寮中的表現。

This year's event was held in Lausanne, Switzerland from 30/10/2000—3/11/2000 with China, Indonesia, France, Poland, Italy and U.S.A. being invited. It would be 24 boards single round robin preliminaries, followed by 36 boards semifinals and 64 boards final. U.S.A. finished 1st in the round robin and picked Indonesia as next opponent, leaving Italy and Poland to cancel each other out hopefully. The full result: USA:50, Indonesia:65; Italy beat Poland 81.5:71. Then Indonesia defeated Italy 124:119 in the finals and USA overcoming Poland 56:52. China came 5th and France 6th.

The Ladies played a rare team of eight with Europe vs USA, a pair each from Germany, France, Norway, Holland defeated 3 USA and 1 Canadian pair 407:402.

Indonesia was a 4-man team, 3 veterans, Manoppo, Lasut, Sacul, all over 53, plus the young Karwur, only 35. Let's see some of their performance.


