In March, LRC Bridge Sub-Committee will be staging a fund raising dinner bridge event to support the Hong Kong Association for Cleft Lip and Palate ([www.cleftlip.org.hk](http://www.cleftlip.org.hk)), a local NGO founded by Mrs. Joanna Chu in 1991 dedicated to support the patients, their parents and caretakers, as well as pregnant mothers bearing affected babies.
