## Hong Kong, China Contract Bridge Association Open League 2024 Supplementary Conditions of Contest

## Laws

The Laws of Duplicate Bridge 2017 will be used.
Unless stated explicitly, the General Conditions of Contest governing HKCBA tournaments will apply.

## Official Language

English is the official language of the tournament. During each match, the players converse only in English unless both captains agree that the players may use some other language at their own risk.

## Registration

Registration was closed on 3I December 2024. The submission of entry for a team means the confirmation by the team that it will be participating in the two Round Robins of the tournament.

## Tournament Format

The competing teams ( 10 teams in Class A and 10 teams in Class $B$ ) shall play two complete round-robins against the teams in the same class, being 9 rounds of I2-board matches in each round robin, each played in one session. Teams will compete in accordance with the schedule.

For Class A, the first round-robin will start on 6 April 2024 (Saturday). The top team with the highest Victory Points after the second round-robins will be declared the winner of Open League 2024. Berth of Class A of the next tournament year will be offered to the top 8 teams with the highest Victory Point after the round robins. The two teams placed $9^{\text {th }}$ and $10^{\text {th }}$ will be moved to Class B automatically in the following year.
For Class B, the first round-robin will start on 13 April 2024 (Saturday). Berth of Class A will be offered to the top 2 teams with the highest Victory Point after the round robins.

In order to secure the berth for the next tournament year, a Team should register with four players, each of whom should have played at least $25 \%$ of the boards for that Team in the round-robins. If this condition is not fulfilled, the Team will be considered as a new team and needs to join Class B in the next tournament year. If there are more berths for the next year, priority will be given to the $9^{\text {th }}$ and $10^{\text {th }}$ team of the original Class A teams followed by the $3^{\text {rd }}$ and $4^{\text {th }}$ placed team in Class B.

## Team Numbers

Team numbers of the first round-robin are drawn on 2 March 2024 (Saturday).
Team numbers of the second round-robin will be based on the ranking of the first round-robin.

## Line-up and Seating

Teams play according to the schedule. The first named team will be the Home Team and the other the Visiting Team. The Home Team sits NS in the Open Room and EW in the Closed Room.
Teams failing to observe the below and causing a delay of the match will be subject to Late Start penalties. There will be NO seating rights in the round-robins. All team captains must complete the line-up 5 minutes before starting time of each match.

## Closed Room

Only the tournament directors and officials may enter and leave the Closed Room during any match.

## Systems \& Conventions

HUM systems and Brown Sticker conventions are not allowed. Psychic of conventional opening bid is prohibited.
All pairs are required to bring 2 copies of duly completed WBF convention card to the tournament, failing which procedural penalties may be imposed.

## Computer Dealt Hands

All teams will play the same set of computer-dealt hands where possible. These hands are generated at random with no special constraints or restrictions.

## Agreement of Results

BridgeMate II will be used as the score input device if available. Discrepancies must be reported no later than 30 minutes after the scores have been posted.

## Change of Players

If, for any reason, a team is unable to produce four players, either at the start of a Session or because of an emergency that develops during the Session, according to Section 18 of the General Conditions of Contest, the Chief Tournament Director, in consultation with the captain of the team, may designate a substitute to complete the team.

## Victory Point (VP) Scale

The WBF 20-point Continuous Victory Point scale will be used.

## Ruling and Review

The TD shall be summoned to a table as soon as attention is drawn to an irregularity. Any review against TD's ruling must be lodged within 30 minutes after the round's end time, or, if the TD's ruling is given after the round's end time, then 30 minutes after that.

Reviews will be heard by a Reviewer appointed by the HKCBA Board of Tournament Directors. The Reviewer shall review the case in accordance with WBF Code of Practice for Reviewers.
If, in the opinion of the Reviewer, there is insufficient basis for requesting the review, a standard penalty will be deducted from the score of the requesting side.

## Eligibility for Awards

The winning team of each match will be awarded Master Points in accordance with the HKCBA Master Points Plan details of which are on the HKCBA website. In order to qualify for the GP won by the team, a player, in any case, must have played at least $25 \%$ of the total number of hands in the round-robins.

- Each I2-board match 2 BPs for win, I BP for tie
- Overall (Class A) 6 GPs for the winning team

3 GPs for the first runner-up
2 GPs for the second runner-up

## Tournament Fee

The total tournament fee is $\mathrm{HK} \$ 3,000$ per team which includes the entry fee for the round robins.
